




# El rescate en la Mina

- Opera desde: mediados del siglo XIX. Proprietarios: "San Esteban Primera S.A."
- Cerrada por accidentes: entre marzo de 2007 y el 30 de mayo de 2008

- Total: 33 (32 chilenos y 1 boliviano)
- Máyor: Mario Gómez, 63 años
- Menor: Jimmy Sánchez, 19 años
- Orden de salida: 1°: los hábiles, 2°: los débiles, 3°: los fuertes
- Primero en salir: Florencio Ávalos
- Último en salir: Luis Urzúa (jefe de turno y líder del grupo)
- Luego de que subiera el último minero salieron los rescatistas que habían bajado para revisar su estado de salud y prepararlos para el ascenso.

to the results of his deeds.**

trespasses and sins, in which  
you formerly walked according

according to the prince of the
