In Spirit And In Truth



John 4: 20 - 24

9 *Desire of his strength I will give heed unto thee; For God is my high tower.*
10 *My God with his lovingkindness will meet me: God will let me see my face upon mine enemies.*
11 *Slay them not, lest my people forget: Scatter them by thy power, and bring them down, O Lord our shield.*
12 *For the sin of their mouth, and the words of their lips, Let them even be taken in their pride, And for cursing and bitterness which they speak.*
13 *Consume them in wrath, consume them, so that they shall be no more: And let them know that God ruleth in Jacob, Unto the ends of the earth.*
14 *And at evening let them return, let them howl like a dog, And go round about the city.*
15 *They shall wander up and down for food, And tarry all night if they be not satisfied.*
16 *But I will sing of thy strength; Yea, I will sing aloud of thy lovingkindness in the morning: For thou hast been my high tower, and a refuge in the day of my distress.*
17 *Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing praises: For God is my high tower, O God of my mercy.*

Lowest over Babyl in Gethse, and Feast for House.

60 *O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast broken us down; Thou hast been angry; oh restore us again.*

9 *Who will bring me into the strong city? Who hath led me unto Ephraim? Hast not thou, O God, cast us off? And thou restest not forth, O God, with our hosts.*
10 *Give us help against the adversary; For vain is the help of man.*
11 *Through God we shall do valiantly; For he it is that will tread down our adversaries.*

Seditions in God's Protection.

2 *He only is my rock and my salvation: He is my high tower; I shall not be greatly moved.*
3 *How long will ye set upon a man, That ye may slay him, all of you, Like a leaning wall, like a tottering fence?*
4 *They only consult to thrust him down from his dignity: They delight in lies; They bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly.*

5 *My soul, wait thou in silence for God only: For my expectation is from him.*
6 *He only is my rock and my salvation:*

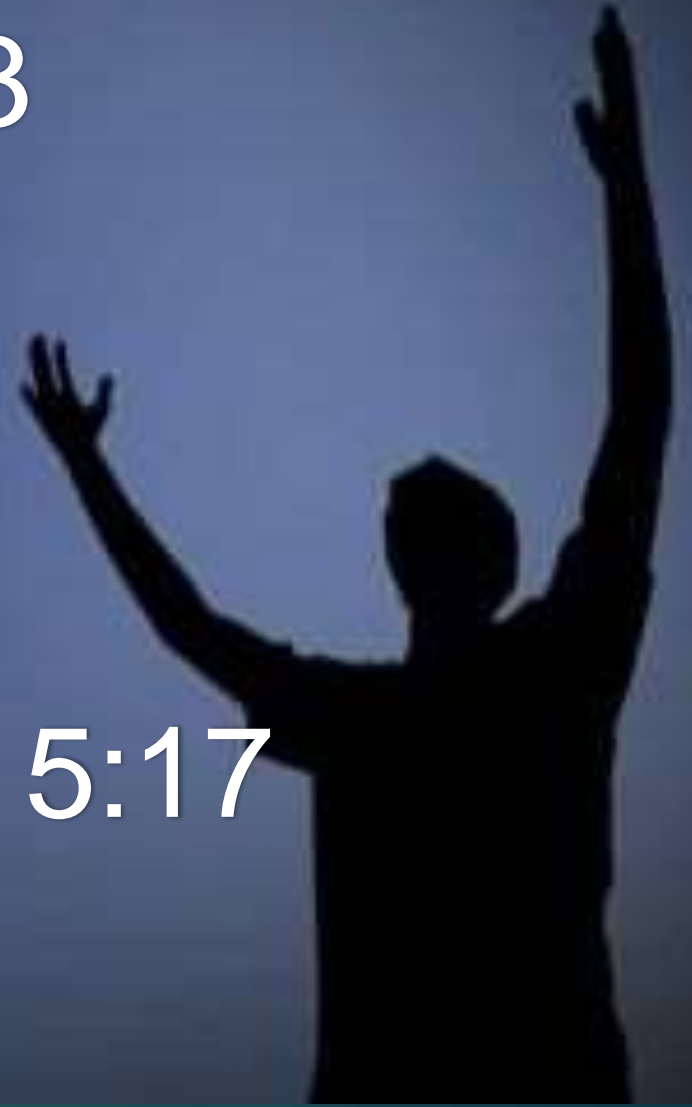

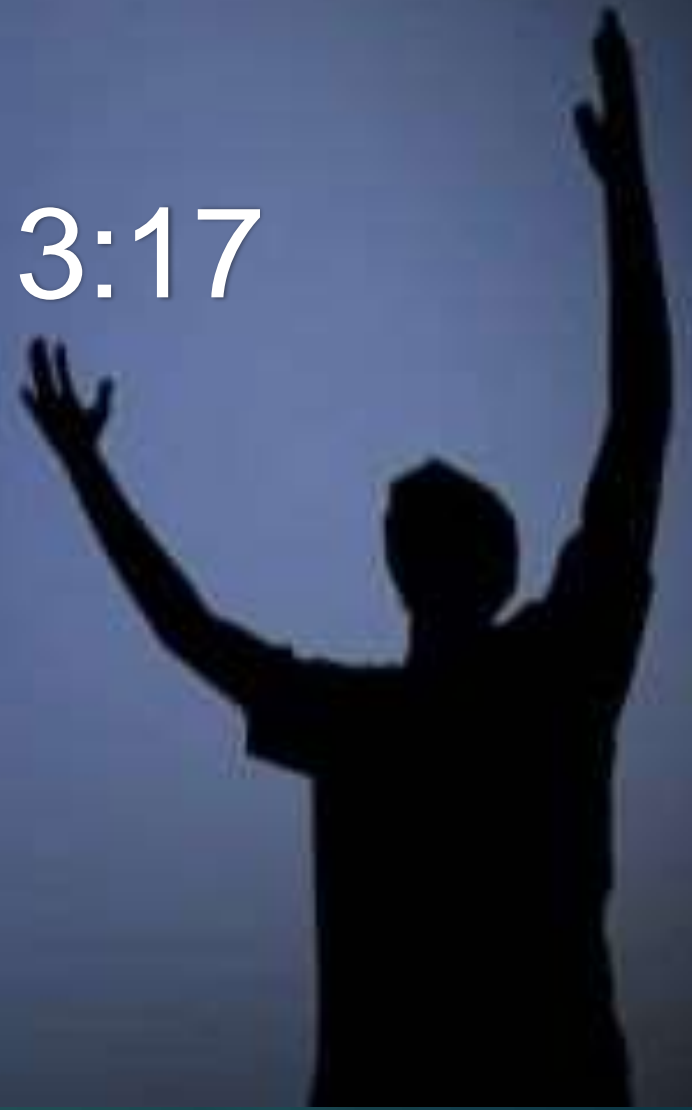
