Genesis

1:26-31

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9 *Because of his strength I will give head unto thee; For God is my high tower.*

10 My God with his lovingkindness will meet me: God will let me see my face upon mine enemies.

11 Slay them not, lest my people forget: Scatter them by thy power, and bring them down, O Lord, our shield.

12 For the sun of their mouth, and the words of their lips, Let them even be taken in their pride, And for cursing and biting which they speak.

13 Consume them in wrath, consume them, so that they shall be no more: And let them know that God ruleth in Jacob, Unto the ends of the earth.

14 And at evening let them return, let them howl like a dog, And go round about the city.

15 They shall wander up and down for food, And tarry all night if they be not satisfied.

16 But I will sing of thy strength: Yea, I will sing aloud of thy lovingkindness in the morning: For thou hast been my high tower, And a refuge in the day of my distress.

17 Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing praises: For God is my high tower, O God of my mercy.

Lowest over Defeat is Death, and Power for None.

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PSALMS 60:2-62:6

2 Thou hast made the land to tremble; thou hast rent it: Heal the breaches thereof, for it shaketh.

3 Thou hast showed thy people hard things: Thou hast made us to drink the wine of staggering.

4 Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, That it may be displayed because of the truth. (S^clah)

5 That thy beloved may be delivered, Save with thy right hand, and answer us.

6 God hath spoken in his holiness: I will exult; I will divide Shechem, and mete out the valley of Succoth.

7 G^o G^o Ad is mine, and M^a na's^a seh is mine; E^r ra-im also is the defence of my head: In ^sah is my sceptre.

8 S^o G^o Ab is my stronghold: Upon E^r dom will I cast my shoe: Thi-is-ti-a, shout thou because of me.

9 Who will bring me into the strong city? Who hath led me unto E^r dom? Hast not thou, O God, cast us off? And thou quest not forth, O God, with our hosts.

10 Give us help against the adversary: For vain is the help of man, Through God we shall do valiantly: For he it is that will tread down our adversaries.

Sanctify in God's Protection.

For the Chief Musician: an Overture. *Psalm of David.*

61 Hear my cry, O God: Attend unto my prayer.

1 From the end of the earth will I call unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed:

1 Another reading is, My strength is God, thou hast broken us down, thou hast been angry, and we are restored again.

3 For thou hast been a refuge for me.

4 A strong tower from the enemy, I will dwell in thy tabernacle for ever: I will take refuge in the covert of thy wings. (S^clah)

6 Thou wilt prolong the king's life: His years shall be as many generations.

7 He shall abide before God for ever: Oh procure lovingkindness and truth, that they may preserve him.

8 So will I sing praise unto thy name for ever, That I may daily perform my vows.
