1. Grace

- Grace is God's loving activity towards mankind.

justification:

declared righteous; to be considered holy on the merit of Christ's finished work on the CROSS, and to have His righteousness imputed (applied) to us.

Faith. The end result is a
'right standing' with God
through the forgiveness of
sin.

3. Sanctification

- Deals with a believer's freedom from the dominion of sin.
- Results in our deliverance.

Justification is the immediate impact of GRACE upon our lives.

It means to Declare Righteous.
