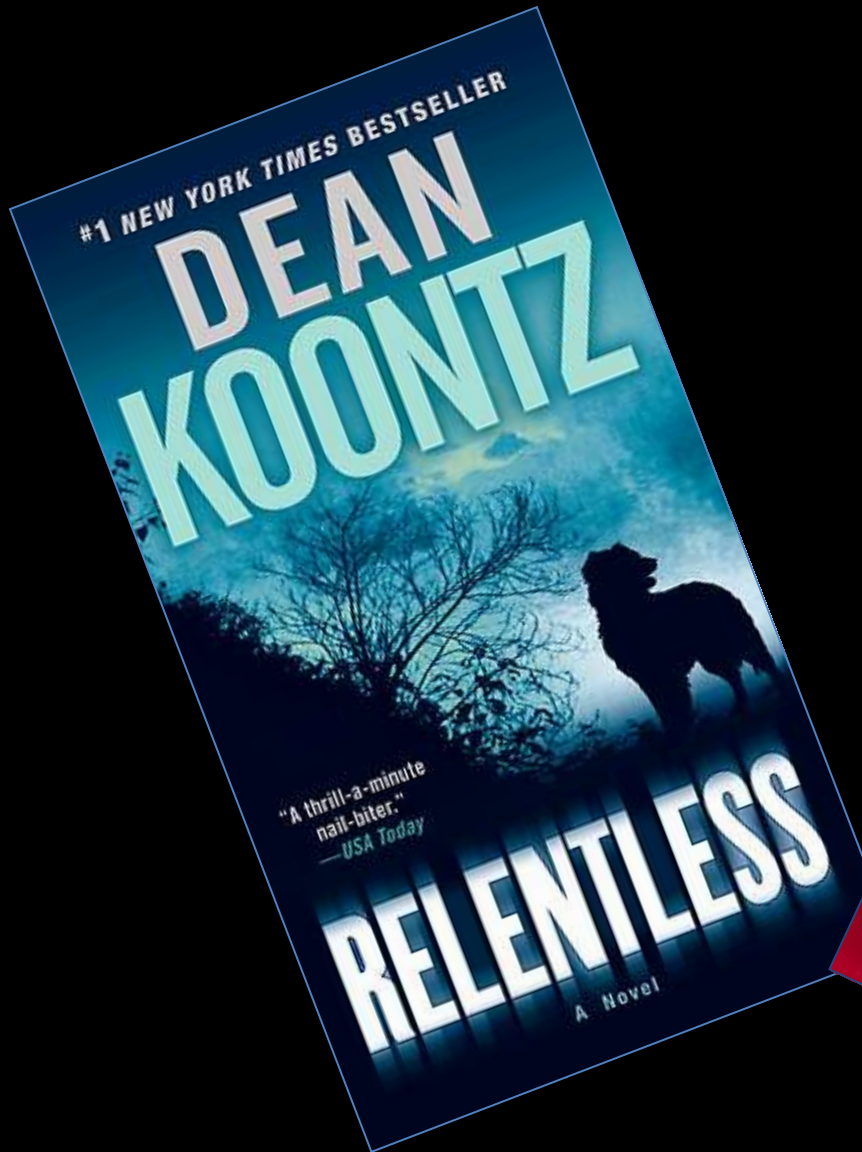

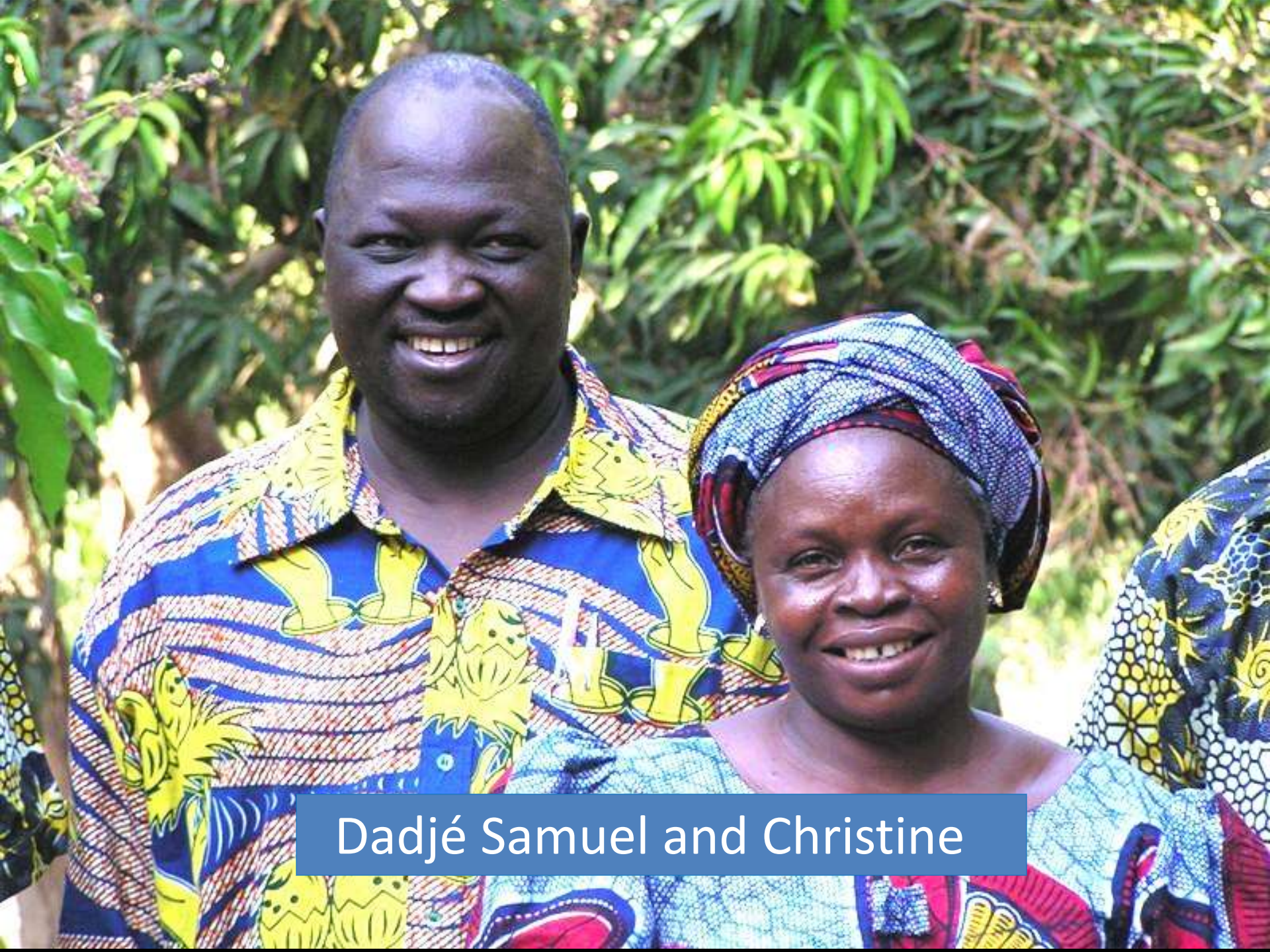

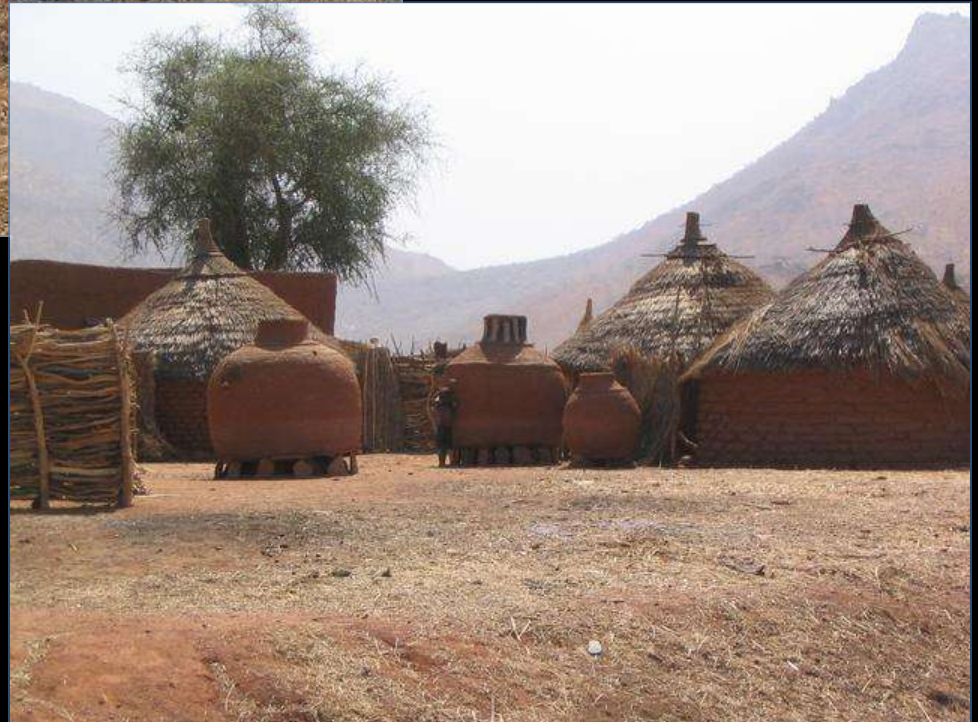


Re • lent • less : showing or promising

and purify us from all unrighteousness.*

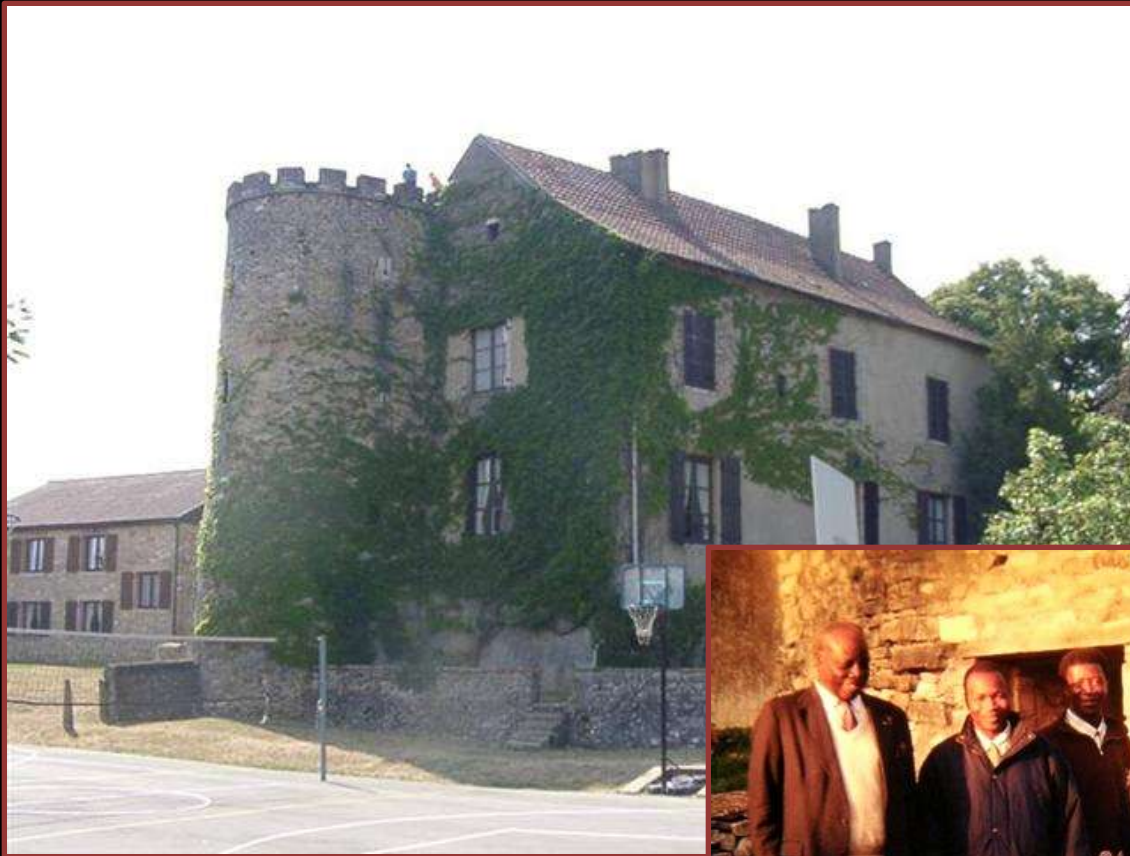
