### **OUR STORY**

Both Debbie and I were raised in Christ-centered homes and trusted Jesus as our Savior at the age of eight. Debbie's parents frequently hosted missionaries in their home and through the influence of their stories, Debbie wanted to become a missionary when she grew up. During my 4 year tour of duty in Germany with the U.S. Air Force I was involved with the Navigators' Serviceman's ministry. I attended the Navigators' International Congress on Disciple Making in Essen, Germany just before returning to the U.S. It was at this international gathering that I learned about the great spiritual need in Asia—what we call the "10/40 Window" today.

I returned to the U.S. in 1977 and began attending the Long Beach Grace Brethren Church where Debbie and I met. She graduated from Biola University with a BS in nursing; I completed my TH.B. in Biblical Studies and M.A. in Missions and Asian Studies at Grace Graduate School and Bible Institute. In 1980, I was invited to join the pastoral staff at the Long Beach Grace Brethren Church to develop a ministry to International Students which God used to point us to the least reached people of Japan, where only 0.05% claim to follow Jesus.

In August of 1984 we were sent to open a new church planting network in Japan. In 2001, Encompass World Partners envisioned a new window of opportunity to reach a large number of Japanese who were working and studying outside the cultural pressures of their homeland. This lead us to being strategically reassigned in Southern California with the goal of making disciples among Japanese Returnees and equipping them to partner with disciple making and church planting ministries when they returned to Japan.
