CHATEAU OF SAINT ALBAIN:

- <u>Urgent prayer requested!</u> The CEP-Chateau committee, of which I am a part, will be interviewing a second candidate for the position of director this Thursday, January 7. Please pray for wisdom as we prayerfully consider the options and make decisions that will affect the future of this ministry.
- Thanks for praying for the Live Nativity and Christmas Market. Over 1400 people came through the Chateau and heard the biblical story of Jesus' birth. About 300 people accepted a Gospel of Luke and about 170 children took a booklet offered to them.
- As treasurer, I continue to do the bookkeeping by going up to the Chateau at regular intervals. Pray for wisdom as I field various questions from the Chateau staff. In the not-too-distant future I will be working on the year-end financial statement with the CPA. Please pray for my on-going testimony to Denis.
- Pray for Bruce and Karen Beck who are currently in the States through February 8 to attend Engage 5 training with Encompass in Atlanta. We had a special dispensation for them to attend after their arrival in France (on June 1) because of the urgent personnel needs. We already miss them and look forward to their return. They're doing a wonderful job as they work alongside Christelle.
- Pray for Claire Martin who spent her childhood years in France when her parents were a part of our missionary team. She is now targeting to arrive in France the beginning of April for a 2-year ministry at the Chateau. She, too, is currently attending the Engage 5 training in Atlanta. Pray as she raises the remainder of her support and that the visa process will go without a hitch.



HOUSE GROUP: Friday, January 8, we will begin a biweekly series on the Beatitudes. Pray that we will grow in our obedience to Christ through these practical exhortations. Please continue to pray for the salvation of several "not yet" believers who have been participating in the house group: Annick, Patrick, Lucie and Sophie. (I

- Pray that God would give strength, wisdom and encouragement to Phillippe Viguier, the
 pastor of the Villeurbanne church. It's not easy to follow in the footsteps of Pastor Florent
 Varak who had served there for 25 years.
- Pray for Jean-Daniel as he serves as an intern and gives leadership to youth ministries (as well as a lot of other things!). Many volunteers contribute to the various ministries for children, junior high, youth, and young adults (both students and working people).  in preparation for the annual business meeting to be held in March. Pray for unity, wisdom
