**Now those
who belong to Christ Jesus
have crucified the flesh
with its passions and desires**

Galatians 5:24

**I have been crucified with Christ;
and it is no longer I who live,
but Christ lives in me; and the

I live by faith in the Son of God,
who loved me and
gave Himself up for me.**

**a renewal in which

circumcised and uncircumcised,
barbarian, Scythian,
slave and freeman,
but Christ is all, and in all.**

Colossians 3:11

So, as those who have been
chosen of God, holy and
beloved, **put on** a heart of
compassion, kindness, humility,
gentleness and patience

Colossians 3:12

**bearing with one another, and
forgiving each other, whoever
has a complaint against anyone;
just as the Lord forgave you,
so also should you.**

Colossians 3:13

Beyond all these things
put on love, which is
the perfect bond of unity.

Colossians 3:14

Let the peace of Christ rule in
your hearts, to which indeed
you were called in one body;
and be thankful.

Colossians 3:15

Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God.

Colossians 3:16

Whatever you do
in word or deed,
***do all in the name
of the Lord Jesus,***
giving thanks through Him
to God the Father.
