Exodus



9 *Desire of his strength I will give heed unto thee; For God is my high tower.*
 10 My God with his lovingkindness will meet me: upon mine enemies, they will not see my face: for thou hast broken us down, and thou hast brought us down to the ground.
 11 Slay them not, lest my people forget: scatter them by thy power, and bring them down, O Lord our shield.
 12 For the sin of their mouth, and the words of their lips, let them even be taken in their pride, and for cursing and bitterness which they speak.
 13 Consume them in wrath, consume them, so that they shall be no more: and let them know that God ruleth in Jacob, unto the ends of the earth.
 14 And at evening let them return, let them howl like a dog, and go round about the city.
 15 They shall wander up and down for food, and tarry all night if they be not satisfied.
