Exodus

5:1-17

9 *Because of his strength I will give heed unto them; For God is my high tower.
 10 My God with his lovingkindness will meet me; God will let me see my days upon mine enemies.
 11 Stay them not, lest my people forget; Scatter them by thy power, and bring them down, O Lord our shield.
 12 For the sin of their mouth, and the words of their lips, Let them even be taken in their pride, And for cursing and bair which they speak.
 13 Consume them in wrath, consume them, so that they shall be no more; And let them know that God ruleth in Jacob, Unto the ends of the earth. [Seith]
 14 And at evening let them return, let them howl like a dove, And go round about the camp. They shall wander up and down for food. And tarry all night if they be not satisfied.
 15 But I will sing of thy strength; Yes, I will sing aloud of thy lovingkindness in the measure: For thou hast been my high tower, And a refuge in the day of my distress.
 17 Unto thee, O my strength, will I sing praises; For God is my high tower, the God of my mercy.

Lament over Sestet in Sodoma, and Praise for Horeb.

For his Chief Ministers are a company Ethical, his soldiers, the sons of men; His arm, the strength, with arms unnumbered set with brassworks, and foot, armored in scale of brass; in the Valley of his review he dwelt.

 For he it is that will tread down our adversaries. [Geddeleth in God's Protection, for the Chief Minister; or a stringed instrument, & Psalms of David.]

62 My soul waiteth in silence for God only; From him cometh my salvation;
 2 He only is my rock and my salvation;
 He is my high tower; I shall not be greatly moved.
 3 How long will ye cast upon a man,
 That ye may slay him, all of you.
 Like a leaning wall, like a tottering fence?
 4 They only consult to thrust him down from his dignity; They delight in lies; They bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. [Seith]
 5 My soul, wait thou in silence for God only; For my expectation is from him, He only is my rock and my salvation;






