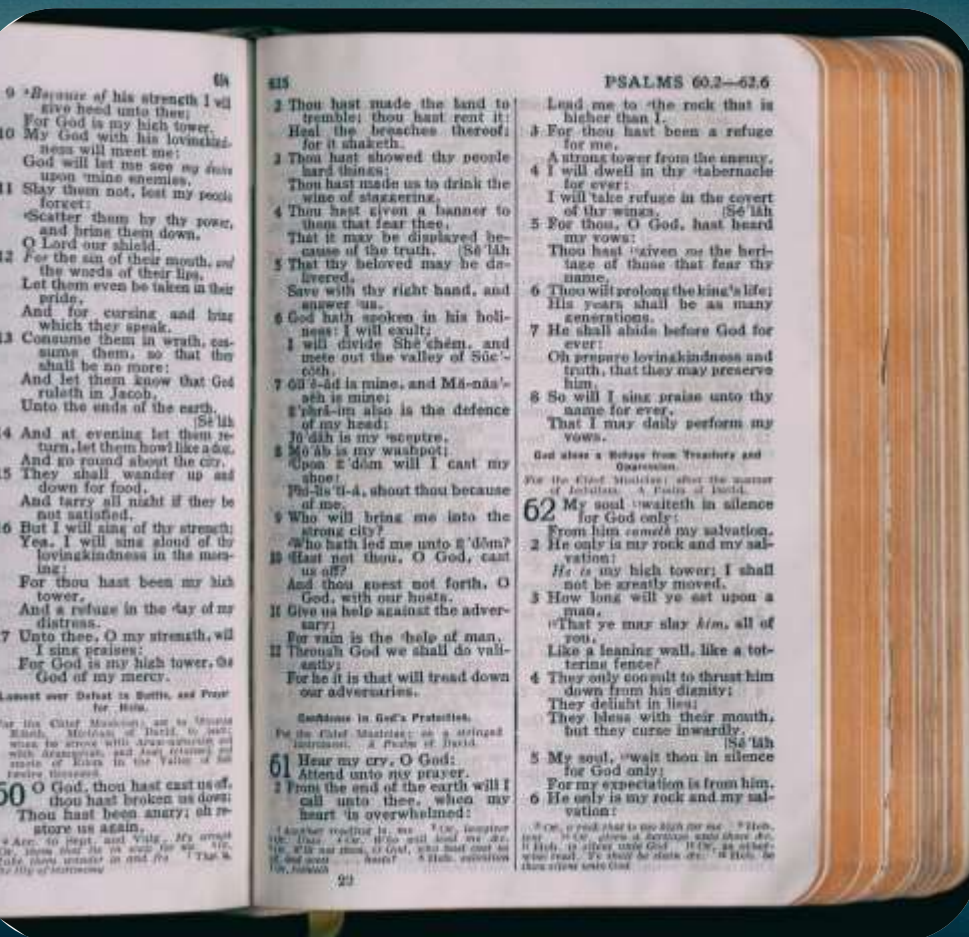


THE MAN

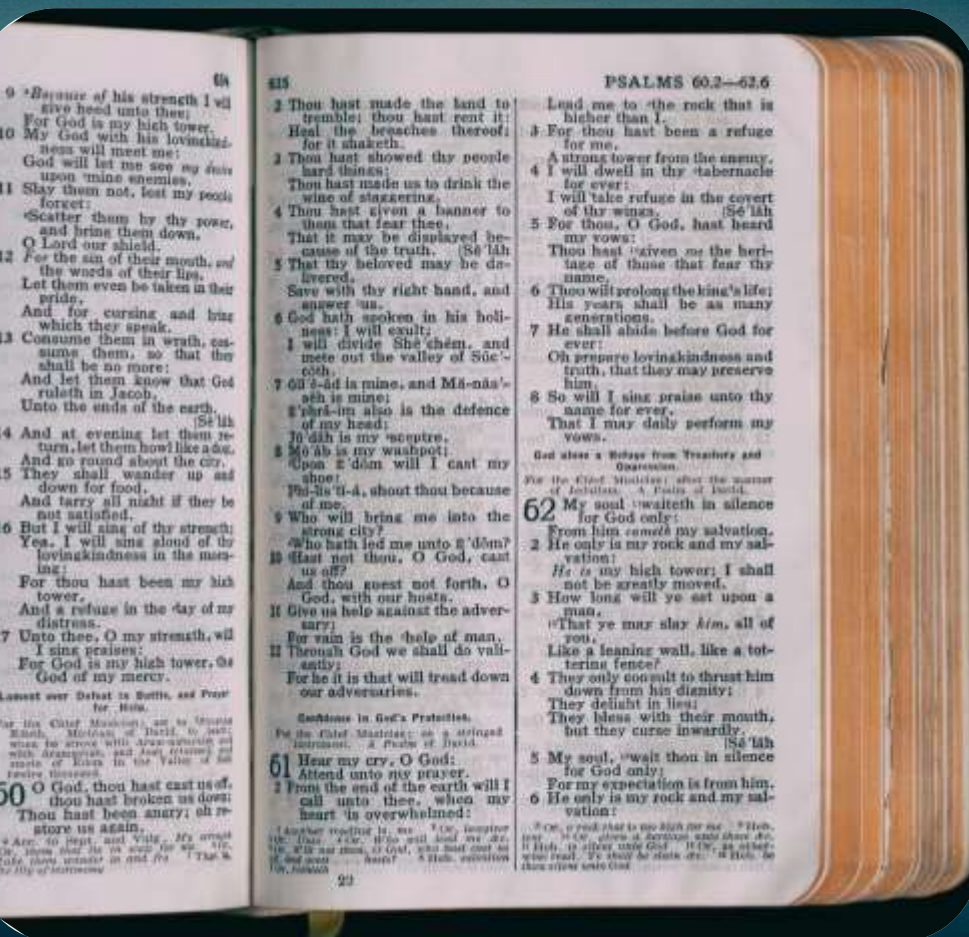

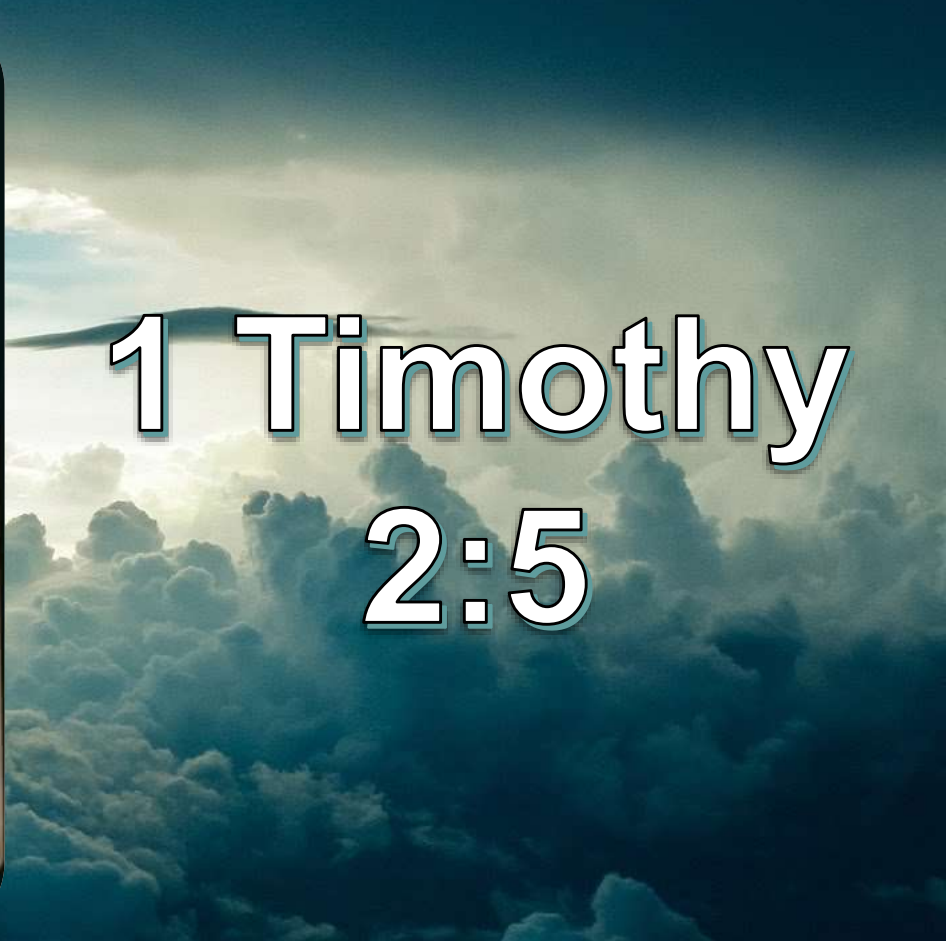
