Acts 16:16-24

9 Because of his strength I will give head unto them:
For God is my high tower.
10 My God with his lovingkindness will meet me:
God will let me see my days upon mine enemies.
11 Stay them not, lest my people forget:
Scatter them by thy power,
and bring them down.
O Lord our shield.
12 For the sin of their mouth, and the winds of their lips,
Let them even be taken in their pride,
And for cursing and lying which they speak.
13 Consume them in wrath, consume them, so that they shall be no more:
And let them know that God ruleth in Jacob,
Unto the ends of the earth. *Se'lah*

4 And at evening let them return, let them howl like a dog,

PSALMS 60:2-63:6

2 Thou hast made the land to tremble; thou hast rent it;

61 My soul waiteth in silence for God only:
From him cometh my salvation.
2 He only is my rock and my salvation:
He is my high tower: I shall not be greatly moved.
3 How long will ye set upon a man,
That ye may slay him, all of you,
Like a leaning wall, like a tottering fence?
4 They only consult to thrust him down from his dignity:
They delight in lies:
They bless with their mouth, but they curse inwardly. *Se'lah*

5 My soul, "wait thou in silence for God only."

*Another reading is, we. The reader
will note that this is the same as
