 3 How long will ye set upon a  
 man,  
 That ye may slay him, all of  
 you,

 4 They only consult to thrust him

 They delight in lies:  
 They bless with their mouth,  
 but they curse inwardly. (S'ah  
 5 My soul, wait thou in silence

 Heb. is silent unto God. Heb. as a tot-  
 tering wall. Heb. they be silent etc. Heb. he  
 shall deliver unto God.
