peace be with you and yours  
as you love the Lord our God  
with all your heart, mind, and  
strength, as you love your  
neighbor as yourself, and as  
you love yourself, that you may  
continue in the love of God  
our Father and of Jesus Christ  
our Lord, the Son of God,  
who has given us the Holy Spirit  
and himself to us, as a pledge  
of our inheritance, so that we  
may know the love of God  
toward us, according to what  
he has promised in the  
scriptures, that we may  
bring forth the fruit of the  
Spirit, which are love, joy,  
peace, patience, kindness,  
goodness, faithfulness, gentleness,  
and self-control. Against such  
there is no law. If you live  
by the Spirit, you will not  
be under the law. For what  
the law was unable to do,  
because of the weakness of  
the flesh, God has done for  
us, sending his Son in the  
likeness of sinful flesh,  
and for our iniquities  
he was made to be  
accused and punished,  
so that we might  
be made right in  
his presence  
by his blood,  
and that we  
might know the  
freedom of his  
glorious grace,  
because we are  
sinners, as all  
the world is,  
yet we are  
now justified  
by his grace  
through the  
redemption  
that is in  
Christ Jesus,  
whom God  
sent as a  
ransom  
for all,  
to set free  
all who are  
under the law,  
so that we  
might be  
dedicated  
to God,  
that we  
might bring  
forth the fruit  
of the Spirit,  
which are love,  
joy, peace,  
patience,  
kindness,  
goodness,  
faithfulness,  
gentleness,  
and self-control.  
If you are  
led by the  
Spirit, you  
will not be  
under the law.  
For what the  
law was  
unable to do,  
because of  
the weakness  
of the flesh,  
God has done  
for us, sending  
his Son in the
