GOT RIGHTEOUSNESS? Romans 1-5 Pastor Roy Halberg

 THE BIG IDEA IS THIS: understanding God's righteousness will change your life → Most, if not all, of the great revivals and reformations in the history of the church have been directly related to the book of Romans
→ The words of this poem capture all that Pastor Rick has been sharing with us in recent weeks:
O long and dark the stairs I trod With trembling feet to find my God Gaining a foothold bit by bit, Then slipping back and losing it.
Never progressing; striving still With weakening grasp and faltering will, Bleeding to climb to God, while he Serenely smiled, not noting me.
Then came a certain time when I Loosened my hold and fell thereby;
Down to the lowest step my fall, As if I had not climbed at all. Now when I lay despairing there, Listena footfall on the stair,
On that same stair where I afraid, Faltered and fell and lay dismayed.
And lo, when hope had ceased to be, My God came down the stairs to me. 1. Let's remember where we've been and where Paul is headed:
1:18-3:20 CONDEMNATION -" NEED OF RIGHTEOUSNESS DEADLINESS OF SIN 3:21-5:21 JUSTIFICATION 6:1-7:25 SANCTIFICATION WAY TO RIGHTEOUSNESS LIFE OF RIGHTEOUSNESS DEMONSTRATON OF SALVATION
2. Your life will be forever changed when/if you grab ahold of some important truths:
A. God's R is needed by each one of us -this is THE key word in Romans (35xs)—we have seen it seventeen times—
-the first 3 chapters of Romans are largely the contrast between a holy, righteous God and unrighteous mankind (1:17-18; 3:5)
→ The message of Romans is simple: God is righteous, we are N God is holy & perfect; we are N WE NEED HIS RIGHTEOUSNESS!!
B. The G is the power of God that leads to salvation, to having God's righteousness
-also a key word in Romans (13xs)—we have seen it five times 1:1, 9, 15-16, 2:16 -GOSPEL= good news it is God's DYNAMITE!!
→ It is IMPERATIVE that you and I understand the gospel hear it and respond to it
C. To fully understand the GOSPEL, God's good news, we must first understand the BNEWS
-there is another key word that we have seen several times in the first five chapters of Romans the word WRATH (1:18-19; 2: 4-8, 4:15; 5:8-11)
→God's wrath is R and it is J

D. JUSTIFICATION is the only solution to this bad news of God's wrath (we have seen this word 13xs- justify, justifies, justification) -to be JUSTIFIED is to be D RNote what Paul has to say about our need to be justified and our acquiring of it 2:13; 3:20, 23-24, 28-30 28; 4:1-8, 4:25-5:1; 5:8-11 -We guilty, sinful people desperately need God's righteousness, we need to be JUSTIFIED. Without it we are doomed to face God's righteous wrath
-That's why Paul rejoices in R being brought into harmony/fellowship with a holy, just, righteous God ("Peace with God" 5:1) Rom 5:10-11.
O WHAT? TAKING IT HOME
Has your life been forever changed by these truths?
Got righteousness?
Have you been declared righteous in God's courtroom because of the sacrifice of Jesus in your place? 1Jn 5:11-13
If you are sure if you are saved and you know it
If you have been delivered from God's wrath and have become a child of God

-Let your face K it!!
-Let your life S it!!
-Let your voice B it!!
