How to Sign up for Bill Pay Online

1. Log in to Your online Banking Website

If you already do online banking – piece of cake! If you don't, you will need to create an account online with your bank – follow the prompts on your banking website to create and acct.

2. Go to “Bill Pay” or “Pay Bill”

Every bank is a little different, but find an icon that allows you to pay a bill or pay a creditor.

3. Add the church as a “Payee”

Choose “Pay a Company” or “Pay a Bill” and add Grace Brethren Church of Norwalk” as a new payee. If it asks for an account number, use your existing envelop # or use “0”.

4. Set – up payment request

You can set up a One -Time payment request or a recurring payment (monthly, weekly, bi-weekly, etc.)

COMMUNION | SEPT 20TH



In preparation for Communion next Sunday and in light of COVID restrictions, we will be participating only in the bread and cup portion of Communion (the Eucharist) during next Sunday's 10am service. If you are participating from home, please have juice & bread available.

BREAD:

"And he took bread, gave thanks and broke it, and gave it to them, saying, "This is my body given for you; do this in remembrance of me." - Luke 22:19

The breaking of bread reminds us that Christ was broken on the cross for us. He willingly gave His body as an atonement for our sin and so we proclaim the Lord's death until he comes again.(1 Cor. 11:26)

CUP:

"In the same way, after the supper he took the cup, saying, "This cup is the new covenant in my blood, which is poured out for you." - Luke 22:20

The cup symbolizes for us that Jesus' innocent blood was willingly poured out of His body on the cross. He suffered and bled as the ultimate sacrifice to cover our sins.
