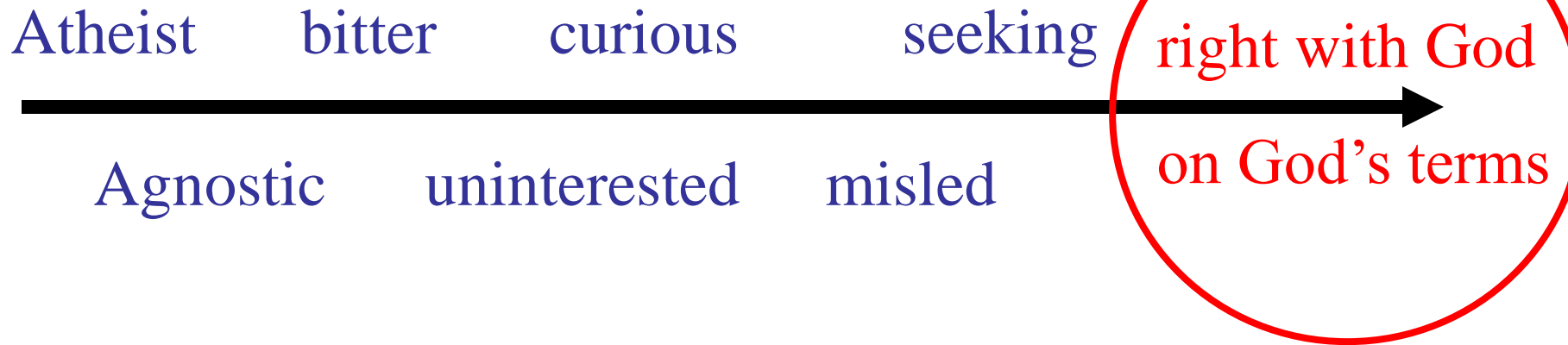




HOW DO I COMPARE TO JOHN THE BAPTIST?
