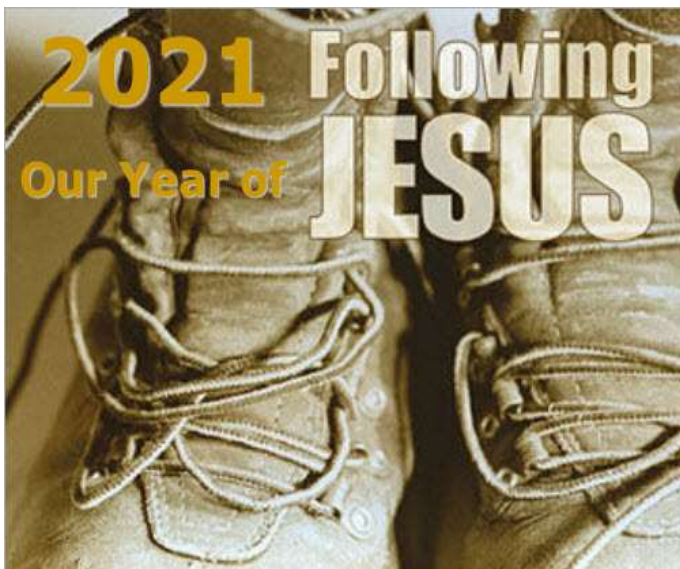

Galatians 3:12 Law vs Faith

The law was given because of mankind's transgressions and fulfilled its requirement when Christ died for you and me.

I've learned from reading God's Word that keeping the Law does not bring a righteousness that God accepts but rather faith in Christ brings a righteousness that God not only accepts but honors

How does faith in Christ bring righteousness? Christ paid for our transgressions on the cross therefore paying for the cost of our sins which is death. If in faith we believe and accept Him as the payment of our sins, we are righteous through Christ, God's appropriation for our sins

Why do we sometimes first start off believing in faith and then later try to earn our salvation through following the law?

Maybe we come to a better understanding of our sinfulness and don't believe that simply having faith in Christ has paid for our sins. We then try to earn our salvation by "doing more" according to the law or our own made-up law.

Maybe we believe we "owe" God and in obligation try to pay Him back through good works and following the law.

We as believers should be thankful that we are no longer under the bondage of sin and the law. Christ has given us the freedom from rules and regulations. We need to step away from these things and step closer to knowing Him more, His purposes and ways. I pray that we will continually seek that relationship with Him throughout our lifetime. Our faith and relationship with Christ saves us, once and for all from ourselves, our selfishness, our sins. As we draw closer to Christ, I pray that our actions and thoughts will be more like His loving, kind, compassionate, patient, steadfast, just, forgiving, generous and wise. – Eddie Morales
