I. Repentance.

- Romans 2:4 NKJV

⁴ Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance, and longsuffering, not knowing that the goodness of God leads you to repentance?

II. Worship.

- Psalm 107:31. KJV
- ³¹ *Oh that men would praise the Lord for his goodness,* *and for his wonderful works to the children of men!*

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

II. Worship.

- Psalm 22:22 ESV

*²² I will tell of your name to my brothers;
in the midst of the congregation I will praise you*

- Luke 17:11-19.
- V15. ¹⁵ *One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. ¹⁶ He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.*
- ¹⁷ *Jesus asked, “Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? ¹⁸ Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?” ¹⁹ Then he said to him, “Rise and go; your faith has made you well.”*

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

III. Desire His word.

- 1 Peter 2:1-3 ESV
- 2 *So put away all malice and all deceit and hypocrisy and envy and all slander.* ² *Like newborn infants, long for the pure spiritual milk,* that by it you may grow up into salvation— ³ *if indeed you have tasted that the Lord is good.*

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

IV. Hope.

- Psalm 27:10-14 ESV
- ¹⁰ *For my father and my mother have forsaken me but the Lord will take me in.*
- ¹¹ *Teach me your way, O Lord, and lead me on a level path because of my enemies.*
- ¹² *Give me not up to the will of my adversaries; for false witnesses have risen against me, and they breathe out violence.*
- ¹³ *I believe that I shall look upon the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living!*
- ¹⁴ *Wait for the Lord;* *be strong, and let your heart take courage;*
wait for the Lord!

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

IV. Hope.

- Psalm 78:7 ESV
- ⁷ *so that they should set their hope in God and not forget the works of God, but keep his commandments;*

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

V. Thankful.

• Psalm 100:4-5. ESV

⁴ ***Enter his gates with thanksgiving, and his courts with praise! Give thanks to him; bless his name!***

⁵ ***For the Lord is good; his steadfast love endures forever, and his faithfulness to all generations.***

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

V. Thankful.

- Psalm 107:1
- *Oh give thanks to the Lord, for he is good,
for his steadfast love endures forever!*

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

VI. Tell others about Jesus.

- Psalm 71:15-24 GNT
- ¹⁵ *I will tell of your goodness;*
all day long I will speak of your salvation,
though it is more than I can understand.
- ¹⁶ *I will go in the strength of the Lord God;*
I will proclaim your goodness, *yours alone.*

How should I Respond to the goodness of God:

VII. Remember “All His Benefits”.

- Psalm 103:1-2 ESV
- *Bless the Lord, O my soul,
and all that is within me,
bless his holy name!*
- ² *Bless the Lord, O my soul,
and forget not all his benefits,*
