Sacrifice = Intimacy with God

As we approach Resurrection Sunday (Easter morning), I can't help but think about God's desire to be close to us! A holy, perfect God who desires to be close and intimate with sinful people. And at what cost? My mind is flooded with the **sacrifice** that God made through His Son Jesus on our behalf.

The word **sacrifice** is not a pretty picture for most people. **Sacrifice** carries with it the idea of death; to kill or to slaughter. But God in His mercy uses sacrifice as a way to bring about life and intimacy with you and I. We see this first example of a substitutionary **sacrifice** just after Adam and Eve sin, *"Also for Adam and his wife the LORD God made tunics of skin, and clothed them."* – **Genesis 3:21**. God covered their nakedness with the skins of an animal/substitutionary sacrifice. This is just a foreshadowing of the fact that God would one day provide a perfect **sacrifice** to cover the sins of His people, through Jesus. From the beginning of our sin journey, God was providing a way to cover us so that we could be close to Him.

Later in the book of Leviticus, we see a whole sacrificial system set up by God, which according to Leviticus 1:4, the **sacrifice** *"...will be accepted on his behalf to make atonement for him"*. This system had to be repeated over and over again to atone for the sins of the people. But again, God in His mercy was preparing His people for the ultimate **sacrifice** that would soon be made. One that only Jesus could fulfill. Jesus became that substitutionary **sacrifice** for you and I.

Today, we are charged by God to be a *"LIVING sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God"* (**Romans 12:1**). Do you see the length and depth of God's love that He would go through to be close to you? Do you desire the same closeness and intimacy with God? Are you seeking Him daily? Are you living for Him?
