- The Imperative of Love

I. Actions of love toward God:

1. "To Follow Him"

- John 6:26-27

"I tell you the truth, you are looking for me, not because you saw miraculous signs but because you ate the loaves and had your fill. Do not work for food that spoils, but for food that endures to eternal life, which the Son of Man will give you. On him God the Father has placed his seal of approval."

I. Actions of love toward God:

1. "To Follow Him"

- John 6:66-68,

"You do not want to leave too, do you?" Jesus asked the Twelve. Simon Peter answered him, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We believe and know that you are the Holy One of God."

Galatians 6

- *9 Let us not, therefore, tire of doing good; because in time we will reap, if we do not faint.*
- *10 So, as we have the opportunity, let us do good to all, and especially to those in the family of faith.*

3. "Tell others what He has done for you" "

- Story of leper

Mark 1

- ⁴⁰ *A man with leprosy came to him and begged him on his knees, “If you are willing, you can make me clean.”*
- ⁴¹ *Jesus was indignant. He reached out his hand and touched the man. “I am willing,” he said. “Be clean!”*⁴² *Immediately the leprosy left him and he was cleansed.*

- ⁴³ *Jesus sent him away at once with a strong warning:* ⁴⁴ *“See that you don’t tell this to anyone. But go, show yourself to the priest and offer the sacrifices that Moses commanded for your cleansing, as a testimony to them.”* ⁴⁵ *Instead he went out and began to talk freely, spreading the news.*

- Mark 5:19
- *"Go home to your family and tell them how much the Lord has done for you, and how he has had mercy on you."*

- 2 Corinthians 5:14-15. NSAB
- ¹⁴ **For the love of Christ controls us**, having concluded this, that one died for all, therefore all died; ¹⁵ and He died for all, so that those who live would no longer live for themselves, but for Him who died and rose on their behalf.

- 1 Corinthians 13:4

4 Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. 5 It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. 6 Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. 7 It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.


- **8 Love never fails.**
