A Practical, Steadfast Faith

Faith is such an important topic to talk about. Paul talks about it in Romans and in many of his epistles; it is also a central theme in the book of James, as well. As we dive into the book of James on Sunday mornings, we will get a picture of how practical this book is to our everyday life. As Pastor Oscar stated last Sunday, James is not packed full of doctrinal topics, but practical advice for living out our faith as a follower of Jesus.

James can also be known as a book of Tests. God is testing our faith to see if we have genuine faith, real faith. As chapter 1 opens we see that God tests faith by trials. If we are honest, most of us are not a fan of trials. We do everything we can to avoid them, to steer clear of them and hope we do not have to face them.

Yet, James chapter one states that the testing of our faith through trials produces patience/steadfastness/endurance and verse 4 goes on to say, *“But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing”*.

So, we see that trials in our lives are needed so that we may become mature followers of Jesus – not lacking anything.

God is wanting us to ‘grow up’ in our faith, to excel in our faith, to experience the fullness of our faith in Him. As we adventure together through the book of James, may you grasp the fullness of joy that comes from putting your faith in Jesus!
