The word in Greek

πειρασμός (peirasmos) – Uses that word and translates trial, James 1:2-12

When it comes to 1:13-18 that same word is used, only now it's translated as temptation...

Same word meaning 2 different things, have you ever seen the in the English language?

Homonyms are words that have the same spelling and pronunciation, but different meanings. It's tricky when words sound the same but can mean different things. This is where context clues come into play.

The external trial can become an internal temptation to sin...

"Temptation are opportunities to choose something other than God.

-All temptation is rooted in the lie that something other than God and His will can meet my need or bring me satisfaction"

The reason why God doesn't do that to the believer

Is His nature to operate according to His goodness and kindness, not to tempt people to make them fail. His goodness won't allow it

There is a struggle within our hearts....

Galatians 5:16

¹⁵ **For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; and these are contrary to one another, so that you do not do the things that you wish.**

Paul told the church in Rome about the reality of his own struggle

Romans 7

¹⁴ *For we know that the Law is spiritual, but I am fleshly, sold into bondage to sin. ¹⁵ For I do not understand what I am doing; for I am not practicing what I want to do, but I do the very thing I hate. ¹⁶ However, if I do the very thing I do not want to do, I agree with the Law, that the Law is good. ¹⁷ But now, no longer am I the one doing it, but sin that dwells in me. ¹⁸ For I know that good does not dwell in me, that is, in my flesh; for the willing is present in me, but the doing of the good is not. ¹⁹ For the good that I want, I do not do, but I practice the very evil that I do not want. ²⁰ But if I do the very thing I do not want, I am no longer the one doing it, but sin that dwells in me.*

The trial = from God

The temptation = from you
