How important is God's word to you?

A survey from 2021 found that **11 percent of Americans read the Bible daily.** (98% of Americans claim to be Christians) Trends in reading habits over four years showed that the majority of Americans never read the Bible.

Bible readership demographics

Bible readership varies across each demographic, with Millennials most likely to have never read the Bible, whereas the **most frequent readers** were those aged over 70 years old.

Changes in attitudes have not been drastic, but rather it seems that disengagement with the Christian scripture has been a gradual process.

Context:

- **Do not be deceived**, my beloved brethren.

James reveals three attitudes that are necessary for believers to rightly receive God's word

I. Be _____ to _____ the truth from God's Word.

V.19a Therefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be quick to listen

Quick= *tachy* - means

A very brief period of time, with focus on speed of an activity or an event." (Listen)

It carries with it a sense of urgency in both time and speed

If you want to succeed in life "Learn to listen to God"

Why is it so important to learn to listen if we want to be successful in life?

Not knowing how to listen many times our misunderstandings leads us to make the wrong decisions that we later regret, "If only I had listened, I would have avoided this or that"

"Listen and you will be wise; the principle of success is wisdom, and it is often silence"

"Knowledge corresponds to speaking, and the privilege of wisdom is to listen."

Proverbs 18:13
