Matthew 6:19-21,

Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth where moth” –“and ***rust*** destroy and where thieves break in and steal; But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust ***destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. for where*** your treasure is **“there your heart will be also.”**

Luke 3,

11 And he answered them, “Whoever has two tunics is to share with him who has none, and whoever has food is to do likewise.” 12 Tax collectors also came to be baptized and said to him, “Teacher, what shall we do?”

13 And he said to them, “Collect no more than you are authorized to do.”

14 Soldiers also asked him, “And we, what shall we do?” And he said to them, “Do not extort money from anyone by threats or by false accusation and be content with your wages.”

James Tells us three things that Greed leads you to

I. Greed leads to *misery*. V. 1-3

- ¹ *Now listen, you rich people, weep and wail because of the misery that is coming on you.*
- “Weep,” *klausate* = “to sob out loud,” it’s not a silent crying.
It means “to weep in a lamenting way.”
- As a result of trusting money and material possessions and not in GOD

13 Someone in the crowd said to him, "Teacher, tell my brother to divide the inheritance with me."

14 Jesus replied, "Man, who appointed me a judge or an arbiter between you?" 15 Then he said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; life does not consist in an abundance of possessions."

8 *But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that.*

- *⁴ Look! The wages you failed to pay the workers who mowed your fields are crying out against you. The cries of the harvesters have reached the ears of the Lord Almighty.*
- *⁵ You have lived on earth in luxury and self-indulgence. You have fattened yourselves in the day of slaughter.*
- *⁶ You have condemned and murdered the innocent one, who was not opposing you*

- **Prov. 22:22-23**

²² Do not exploit the poor because they are poor and do not crush the needy in court,

²³ for the Lord will take up their case and will exact life for life.

- **Deuteronomy 24:14-15**

¹⁴ Do not take advantage of a hired worker who is poor and needy, whether that worker is a fellow Israelite or a foreigner residing in one of your towns. ¹⁵ Pay them their wages each day before sunset, because they are poor and are counting on it. Otherwise they may cry to the Lord against you, and you will be guilty of sin.

James Tells us three things that Greed leads you to

III. Greed leads to *Self deceiving*. V.5-6

- *⁵ You have lived on earth in luxury and self-indulgence. You have fattened yourselves in the day of slaughter.*

• **Prov. 11:4**

• ***Wealth is worthless in the day of wrath,
but righteousness delivers from death.***

- **Luke 12.**
- ***¹⁶ And he told them this parable: “The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest. ¹⁷ He thought to himself, ‘What shall I do? I have no place to store my crops.’***
- ***¹⁸ “Then he said, ‘This is what I’ll do. I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain.¹⁹ And I’ll say to myself, “You have plenty of grain laid up for many years. Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry.””***
- ***²⁰ “But God said to him, ‘You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself?’***
- ***²¹ “This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God.”***

Luke 16:13-15

- ¹³ *“No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money.”*
- ¹⁴ *The Pharisees, who loved money, heard all this and were sneering at Jesus. ¹⁵ He said to them, “You are the ones who justify yourselves in the eyes of others, but God knows your hearts. What people value highly is detestable in God’s sight.*

• IV. The solution to Greed

Matt.6:19-21

- *¹⁹ “Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moths and vermin destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. ²⁰ But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moths and vermin do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. ²¹ For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.*

- **1. It is more of a blessing to give than to receive.**

- ***Acts 20:35***

³⁵ In everything I did, I showed you that by this kind of hard work we must help the weak, remembering the words the Lord Jesus himself said: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.' ”

- 2. Matt. 22. *Love your neighbor as yourself.*

Checklist:

- **Have an attitude of gratitude; focus on what you have, not on what you don't have.**
- **Become immersed in the scriptures.**
- **Realize that material blessings will not bring peace in this life or joy in the eternal life.**
- **Develop charity; be willing to give, share.**

- **“God, who do you want me to bless that is in real need right now”?**
- **There are children in other countries that by receiving a sandwich or a slice of pizza you light up their face.... (Nicaragua, Mexico, Thailand...). Sponsor some of this kids with bibles, uniforms for school, maybe a meals for Christmas...**
- **Have in your budget a set amount every month to support this kind of missions...**
- **About reaching the lost...**

- 1 Timothy 6:17-19
- ***17 Command those who are rich in this present world not to be arrogant nor to put their hope in wealth, which is so uncertain, but to put their hope in God, who richly provides us with everything for our enjoyment. ¹⁸ Command them to do good, to be rich in good deeds, and to be generous and willing to share. ¹⁹ In this way they will lay up treasure for themselves as a firm foundation for the coming age, so that they may take hold of the life that is truly life.***
