Say “Thank you”. It’s a good thing

“It is a good thing to give thanks to the Lord and to sing praises to Your name, O Most High” (Psalm 92:1)

My mother taught me early the importance of saying “Please” and “Thank you”. It was an obligation. It was a duty. It was required. It was expected.

As I’ve grown older, I understand that saying “thank you” is a joy. It is a privilege. Often it is an opportunity.

Psalm 92 encourages us simply with the words, “it is a good thing”.

No duty. No obligation. No requirement. It’s simply good to say thanks.

When you stop and think of all that the Lord has done for all ... all that He has gifted you with ... all that He provides, our simple natural response should be “thank you”. And, as the psalmist suggests, you could even sing your thankfulness!

When I reflect upon Psalm 92, I find myself thinking of the words of the old chorus that I’ve been singing since I was at least five years old: “Thank you, Lord, for saving my soul. Thank you, Lord, for making me whole. Thank you, Lord, for giving to me thy great salvation so rich and free”.

It’s a good thing to say “thank you” . . . so do it right now!
