What happens when you decide to feed your fear instead of your faith?

#1. Number one: Let's establish the scenario

People of Faith and fear go through the same experiences and are exposed to the same things as people of faith.

Numbers 13:23-26

²³ When they reached the Valley of Eshkol, they cut off a branch bearing a single cluster of grapes. Two of them carried it on a pole between them, along with some pomegranates and figs. ²⁴ That place was called the Valley of Eshkol because of the cluster of grapes the Israelites cut off there. ²⁵ At the end of forty days they returned from exploring the land. ²⁶ They came back to Moses and Aaron and the whole Israelite community at Kadesh in the Desert of Paran. There they reported to them and to the whole assembly and showed them the fruit of the land.

They saw the evidence of good things

Several lessons to learn here:

1. God doesn't want you to let fear decide your future

Never go into the future deciding upon the fears in your life

When fear controls your decision it's the wrong decision

There are two things that they did that I think really caused the third thing but let me give it to you right now first of all people that feed their fears like the people here

2. People feed their fear when they forget the past, in other words they forget what God had done for them

3. The second thing is that they became satisfied with the present

Fears will destroy you

Fear is the reason you won't live a fulfilling life.

Fear is the reason you'll leave this life with so much left to do.

Fear is the reason you'll be flooded with regrets when you're faced with your mortality.

Fear is the reason you'll never quite achieve what you set out to do.

Fear will hold you prisoner in your own desert

Fear will tell you that you're not good enough or you're not ready.
