I. Knowing God will feed your Faith... They Remember who God is

- Hebrews 13:8

⁸ *Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.*

Joshua & Caleb:

II. Prayer will feed your faith. Joshua was a man of prayer.

Joshua 10:12

Then Joshua spoke to the LORD in the day when the Lord delivered up the Amorites before the children of Israel, and he said in the sight of Israel:

"Sun, stand still over Gibeon; And Moon, in the Valley of Aijalon."

¹³ So the sun stood still, and the moon stopped, till the people had revenge upon their enemies.

But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers."

III. Having the right spirit will feed your faith. Spirit = Attitude

V. You will feed your faith when you live by obedience and not emotions.

Look at what Caleb says

Joshua 14:8

nevertheless, my brethren who went up with me made the heart of the people melt but I wholly followed the Lord my God

Deuteronomy 1:36

³⁶ except Caleb, He will see it, and I will give him and his descendants the land he set his feet on, because he followed the Lord wholeheartedly."

Numbers 14:24 ²⁴ But because my servant Caleb has a different spirit and follows me wholeheartedly,

Joshua 14:8 wholly followed the Lord

⁹ your inheritance and that of your children forever, because you have followed the Lord my God wholeheartedly.'

¹⁴ So Hebron has belonged to Caleb because he followed the Lord, the God of Israel, wholeheartedly.

The wholehearted devotion of Caleb can be summed up in a single word, obedience.

Joshua 14

10 "Now then, just as the Lord promised, he has kept me alive for forty-five years since the time he said this to Moses, while Israel moved about in the wilderness. So here I am today, eighty-five years old! 11 I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me out; I'm just as vigorous to go out to battle now as I was then. 12 Now give me this hill country that the Lord promised me that day. You yourself heard then that the Anakites were there and their cities were large and fortified, but, the Lord helping me, I will drive them out just as he said."
