When we fail to get up and feed our physical body, we get weak and tired and we don't function the way we were meant to. For most of us it's not that there is lack of food to eat, but rather we lack to take action to feed ourselves the healthy food our body needs to function at its best. So, what are you doing in 2023 to 'feed your faith'?

Last week's devotional, Pastor Roy encouraged us to have a bible reading plan for 2023. This is a way to cultivate your faith because as **Romans 10:17** says, "So faith comes from hearing and hearing through the Word of Christ." So, have you picked a bible reading plan yet for 2023? If not, Pastor Roy has one he would love to give you.

Another way to continue to 'feed your faith' is to start memorizing God's Word. Pick a key verse in your weekly reading plan and memorize it. Write it down somewhere you will see it often. Text it to yourself. Put it as your background on your cell phone. Say it out loud to a friend. **Psalm 119:11** says, "I have stored up your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you." Start feeding your faith and watch the Lord begin to remove your fear and help you to overcome your sin. Let's grow together in 2023!
