Pride is a universal human problem and we all, to some degree, suffer from it. It creeps in quietly and overcomes us when we least expect it. C.S. Lewis once stated, *“For pride is spiritual cancer: it eats up the very possibility of love, or contentment, or even common sense.”*

As a follower of Jesus, we must fight against pride every day. Pride will often show up in the way of comparison. We begin to compare ourselves to others: Well, at least I am not like that person! Or at least I don't complain a lot like that person does! **Luke 18:9-14** gives the story of the self-righteous Pharisee and a despised tax collector. Remember this story? Standing at the temple to pray the Pharisee says, *“God, I thank you, that I am not like other men ... or even like this tax collector.”* And then goes on to list all the things that he does right. Whereas the much-despised tax collector standing far away says, *“God, be merciful to me, a sinner!”*

Has pride thrown you into the game of comparison? Do you find yourself quickly comparing yourself against others? If the apostles of Jesus struggled with it as we see in **Luke 22:24-27**, who are we to think we are exempt from falling into pride, ourselves.

Proverbs 3:34 says, *“Toward the scorers he is scornful, but to the humble he gives favor(grace).”* If we want to have favor with God and combat our pride, we must seek a spirit of humility.
