1 Corinthians 15:13-20 NLT

There is No Victory Without the Struggle

Can't be victorious if you never compete - To enjoy the reward you must endure the process

To sing victorious at the podium you must have gone through the pain of hard training

Your greatest victory is on the other side of your greatest struggle.


Doubts can take the peace from you and keep you awake.

HOW DID THE APOSTLES DIE?

1. **Matthew**, by a sword wound.
2. **Mark**, being dragged by Horses through the streets until he was dead.
3. **Luke**, was hanged in Greece
4. **John**, he was boiled in huge Basin of boiling oil. He died as an old man, the only apostle to die peacefully
5. **Peter**, he was crucified upside down on an x-shaped cross.
6. **James**, was thrown over a hundred feet down from the southeast pinnacle of the Temple when he refused to deny his faith in Christ.
7. **James the Son of Zebedee**, was beheaded at Jerusalem.
8. **Bartholomew**, he was flayed to death for his preaching in Armenia.
9. **Andrew**, was crucified on an x-shaped cross in Patras, Greece.
10. **Thomas**, was stabbed with a spear in India during one of his missionary trips to establish the church in the Sub-continent.
11. **Jude**, was killed with arrows when he refused to deny his faith in Christ.
12. **Matthias**, the apostle chosen to replace the traitor Judas Iscariot was stoned and then beheaded.
13. **Paul**, was tortured and then beheaded by the evil Emperor Nero at Rome in A.D. 67.


