 - He was going to redeem Israel

 - it was Jesus teaching the scriptures that gave them assurance . . . the truth of the living Word that spoke to their need

→ God Means Just What He Says (A.B. Simpson)

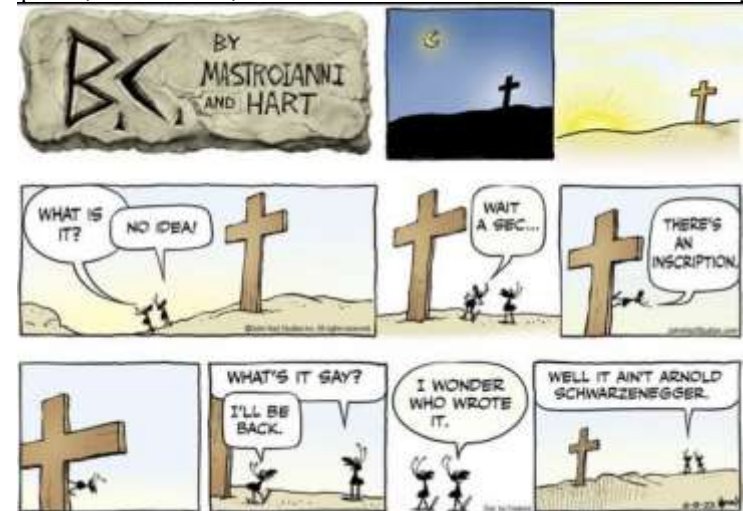
There are some, who believe the Bible,

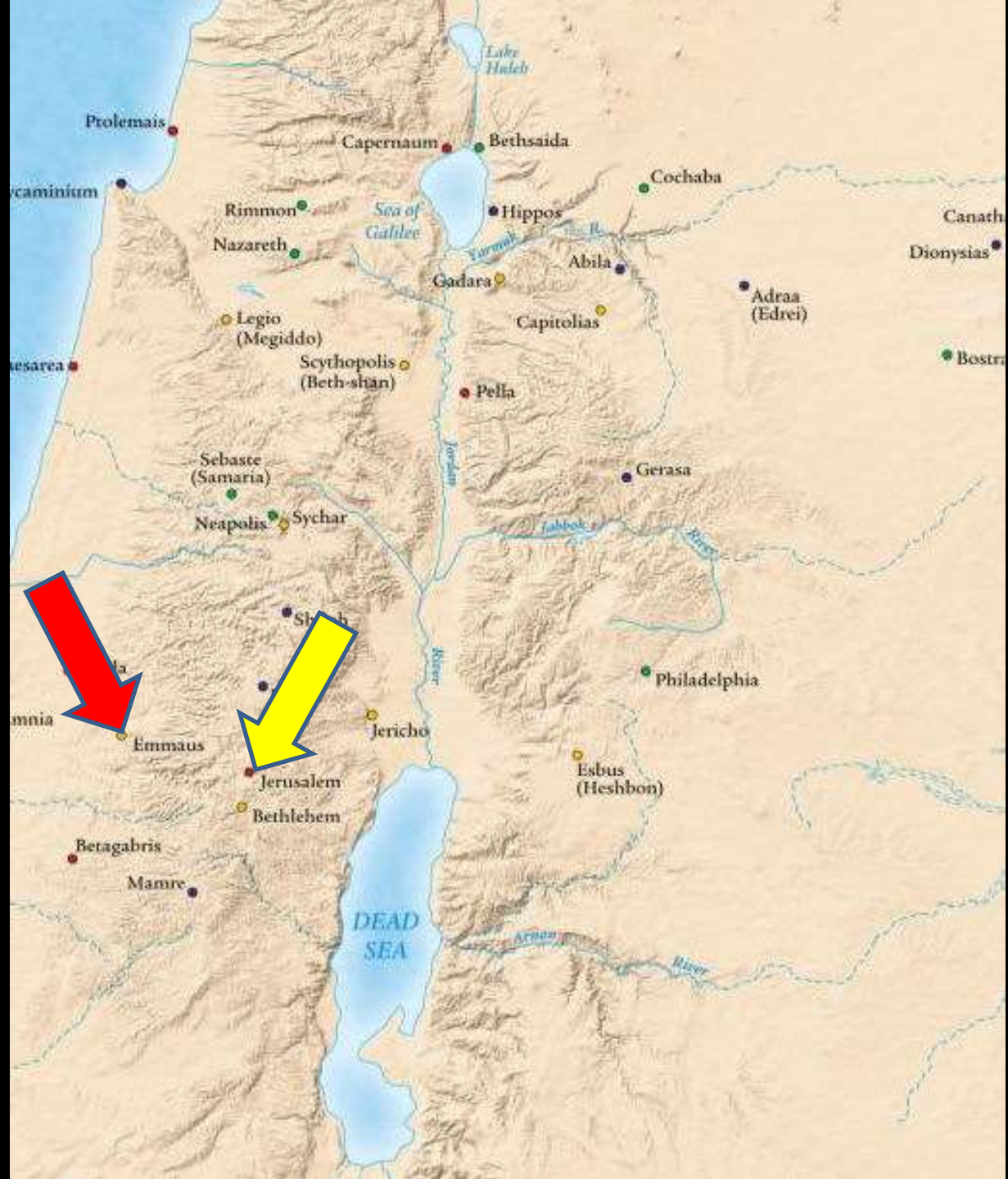
