- A. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO CATCH OUR ATTENTION.

Amos 4:12

"Therefore, I will bring upon you all the disasters I have announced. Prepare to meet your God in judgment, you people of Israel!"



A. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO CATCH OUR ATTENTION.

- 1) When troubles come, it is often a reminder to look to God.
- "Before I was afflicted, I went astray: but now have I kept your word." (Psa 119:67)
- "<u>It is good for me that I have been afflicted</u>; that I might learn your statutes." (Psa 119:71)

B. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO SELF EXAMINATION.

1 Cor. 11:31-32

31 But if we would examine ourselves, we would not be judged by God in this way. 32 Yet when we are judged by the Lord, we are being disciplined so that we will not be condemned along with the world.





C. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO CONQUER OUR PRIDE.

Pr. 8:13

All who fear the Lord will hate evil. Therefore, I hate pride and arrogance, corruption and perverse speech.





D. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO CAUSE US TO CRY TO HIM.

- "The Lord hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles." (Psa 34:17)
- "Then call on me when you are in trouble, and I will rescue you, and you will give me glory." (Psa 50:15)



E. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO REMOVES SHALLOW FRIENDS.

"A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity." (Prov 17:17)





F. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO EQUIP US TO COMFORT OTHERS.

2 Cor. 1:3-5

³ All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. God is our merciful Father and the source of all comfort. ⁴ He comforts us in all our troubles so that we can comfort others.



F. GOD USES ADVERSITY TO EQUIP US TO COMFORT OTHERS.

2 Cor. 1:3-5

When they are troubled, we will be able to give them the same comfort God has given us. ⁵ For the more we suffer for Christ, the more God will shower us with his comfort through Christ.
