Last Sunday, Pastor Paul shared the process of how to overcome discouragement and walked us through the nature, the cause, and the cure when we face moments of discouragement. When discouragement comes knocking on our door, it is never convenient, and it can quickly become debilitating. We all face it. It is around every corner.

Nehemiah had lots of reasons to be discouraged. His enemies mocked him as he began to rebuild the wall. They threatened him with a military attack. They tried to lure him away from the city and the task of rebuilding the wall. They spoke false charges against him. They tried to discredit him and his work. And they even tried to frighten him with spies and letters filled with fear.

When we face those moments, where do we turn, how do we respond?

Do we kneel first? In other words, do we turn to God immediately in times of discouragement and seek Him or do we grumble and complain and give in to discouragement? Prayer helps to keep our focus on God and doesn't allow the discouragement to have a foothold in our lives. Nehemiah models this multiple times: **Nehemiah 1:5-6**, *"I pray, Lord God of heaven … please let your ear be attentive…"* and again in **2:4**, *"So I prayed to the God of heaven."* and again in **4:4** *"Hear, O our God, for we are despised"*.

The next time you are faced with discouragement, stop, and cry out to God and seek His help.
