### 2. REACH | intentionally

*[1 Corinthians 9:22-23; Matthew 28:19-20; Luke 10:1-3]*

**Because Jesus is our hope, we aim to reach every generation with His message of salvation.**

*Luke 19:10 says, "For the Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."*

*John 3:16 says, "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son."*

God Values Lost People and so should we...

- **Luke 5:29.**

<sup>29</sup> Then Levi held a great banquet for Jesus at his house, and a large crowd of tax collectors and others.

<sup>31</sup> Jesus answered them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. <sup>32</sup> I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

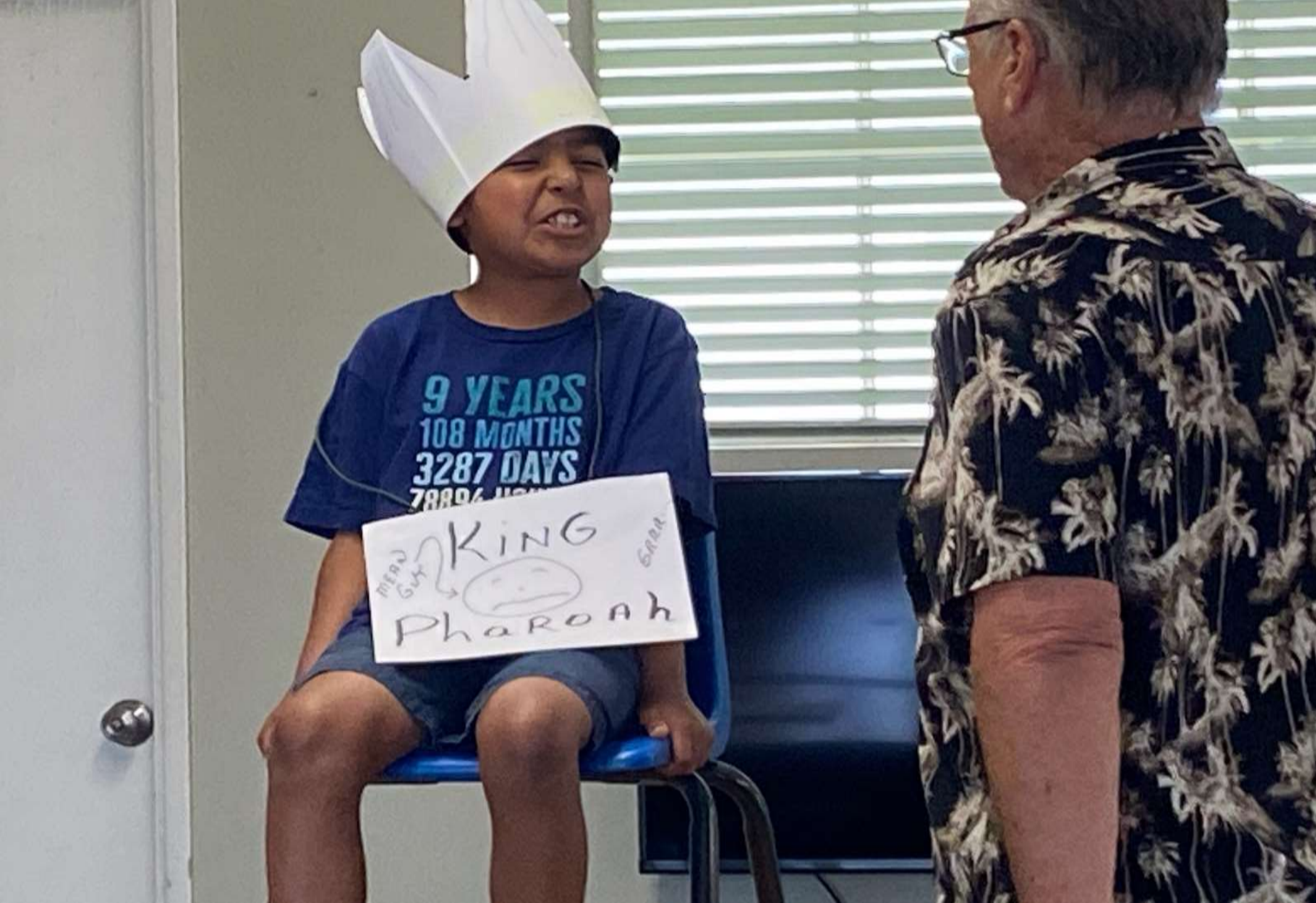

## 1 Corinthians 9:20-22.

<sup>20</sup> When I was with the Jews, **I lived like a Jew to bring the Jews to Christ.** When I was with those who follow the Jewish law, I too lived under that law. Even though I am not subject to the law, **I did this so I could bring to Christ those who are under the law.**<sup>21</sup> When I am with the Gentiles who do not follow the Jewish law, **I too live apart from that law so I can bring them to Christ.** But I do not ignore the law of God; I obey the law of Christ.

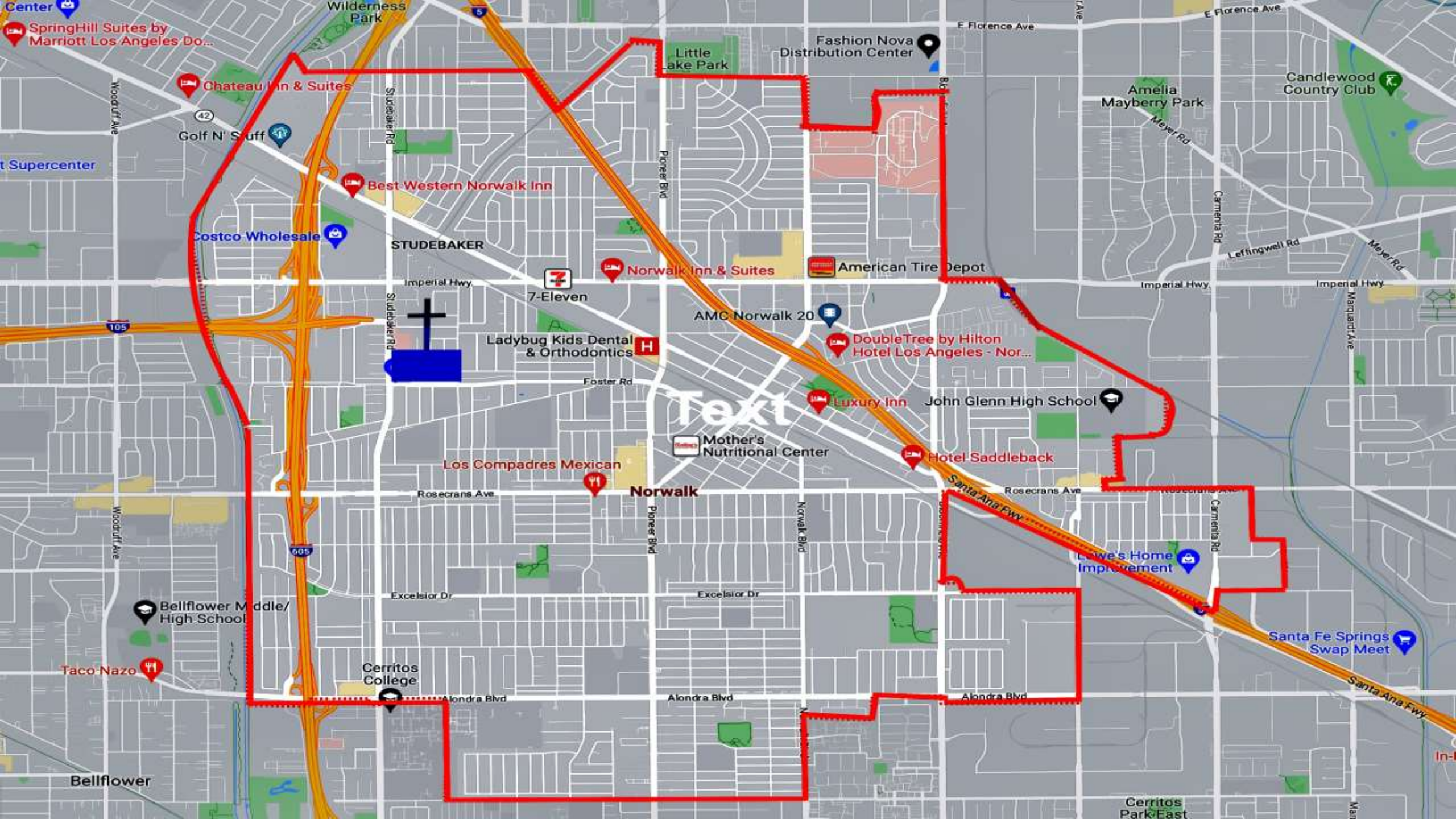

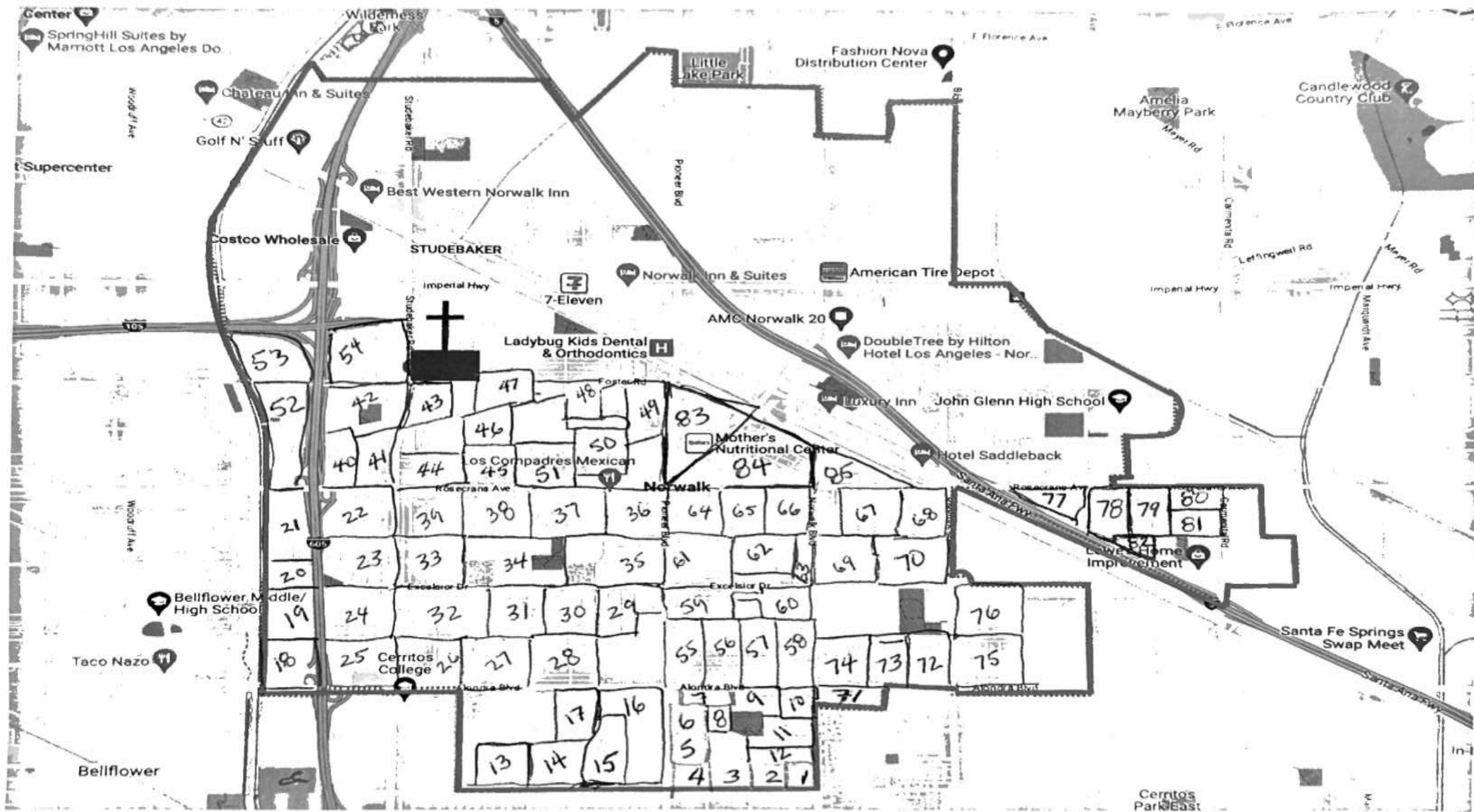

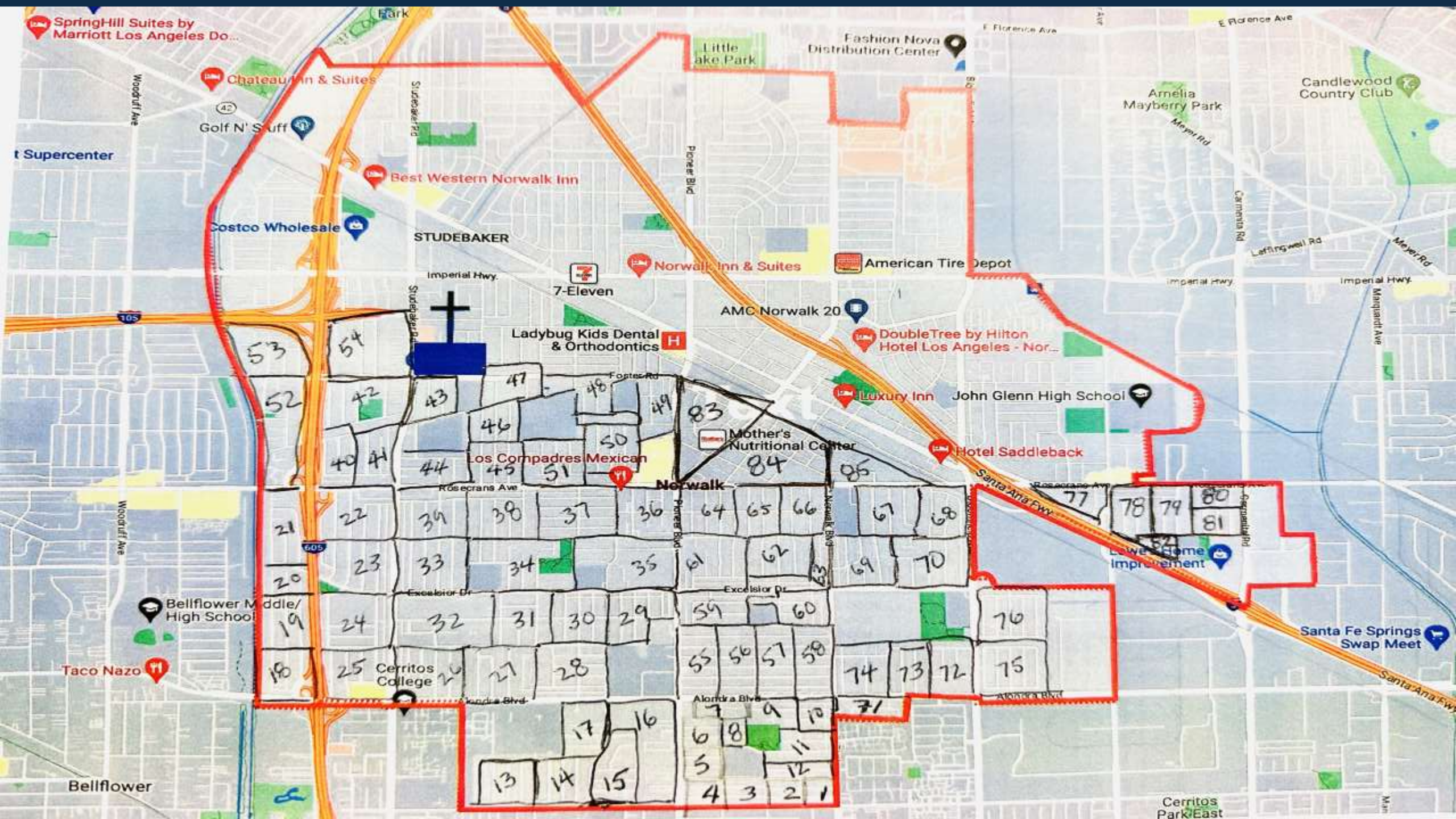
