Our second value is:

2. REACH | intentionally

[1 Corinthians 9:22-23; Matthew 28:19-20; Luke 10:1-3]

Because Jesus is our hope, we aim to reach every generation with His message of salvation.

Luke 19:10 says, "For the Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost."

John 3:16 says, "God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son."

God Values Lost People and so should we...

Luke 5:29.

31 Jesus answered them, "It is not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick. 32 I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance."

Luke 15

1 Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus.

³ <u>Then Jesus told them</u> this parable: ⁴ "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? ⁵ And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders ⁶ and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' ⁷ I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Luke 19:1-10

- ¹ Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through. ² A man was there by the name of Zacchaeus; he was a chief tax collector and was wealthy. ³ He wanted to see who Jesus was, but because he was short he could not see over the crowd. ⁴ So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way.
- ⁵ When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today." ⁶ So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly.
- ⁷ All the people saw this and began to mutter, "He has gone to be the guest of a sinner."
- ⁸ But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, "Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount."
- ⁹ Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham. ¹⁰ For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."

²⁹Then Levi held a great banquet for Jesus at his house, and a large crowd of <u>tax collectors and others.</u>

1. We need compassion.	
Luke 15:2 "we	elcomes sinners and eats with them."
2. We need initiative.	
First, a signific	cant part of our prayers should be for the lost.
3. We need persistence.
