- -What does a transformed life look like?
- -I'd like to suggest one of my heroes . . . Ezra
 - The <u>reputation</u> he had in the community: "a scribe skilled in the law of Moses" v6
 - The relationship he had with God: "the good hand of His God was upon Him" v6, 9, 28 (also see 8:22 "the hand of our God is favorably disposed to all who seek Him")
 - The reason for God's hand of blessing on his life v10
 - He "set his heart" to do three things:
 - "Study the law of the Lord"
 - ✤ "Practice" the law of the Lord
 - ✤ "Teach" the law of the Lord
- -I wonder what God could do with a church full of people whose lives had been so transformed by God's word to be like Jesus and touch people with the hope of the life changing relationship with Jesus . . .


