- This was the Apostle Paul's ambition and goal (Col 1:28-29)
“... so that we may present every man complete in Christ”
- How important was this to Paul?
“for this purpose also I labor, striving . . .”

1 John 2:14 I write to you young men because you are strong and the word of God abides in you and you have overcome the evil one”

- What does a transformed life look like?
- I'd like to suggest one of my heroes . . . Ezra
 - The reputation he had in the community: “a scribe skilled in the law of Moses” v6
 - The relationship he had with God: “the good hand of His God was upon Him” v6, 9, 28 (also see 8:22 “the hand of our God is favorably disposed to all who seek Him”)
 - The reason for God's hand of blessing on his life v10
He “set his heart” to do three things:
 - ❖ “Study the law of the Lord”
 - ❖ “Practice” the law of the Lord
 - ❖ “Teach” the law of the Lord
- I wonder what God could do with a church full of people whose lives had been so transformed by God's word to be like Jesus and touch people with the hope of the life changing relationship with Jesus . . .

We want to be a church that directs people into God's word in ways that promote maturity as disciples of Jesus who are seeking to live life in obedience to the truth of the scriptures . . . people who listen to Jesus and do what He says

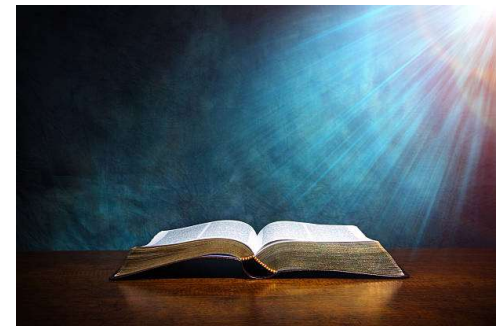

It's All About Change

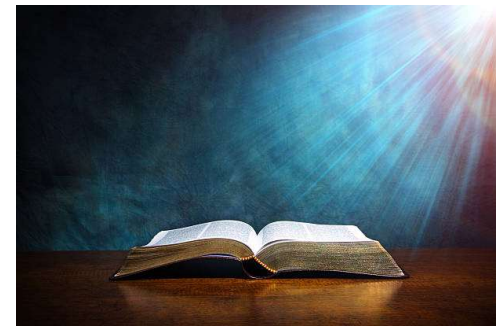
→ Picture yourself hiking a mountain trail

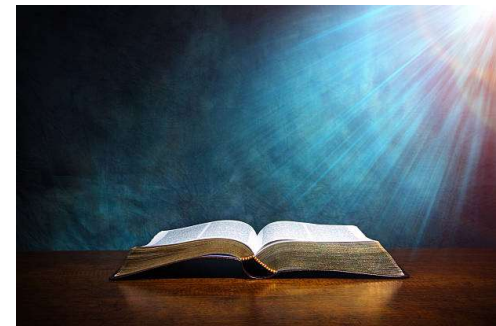

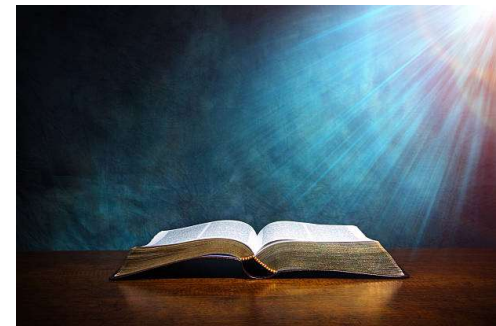

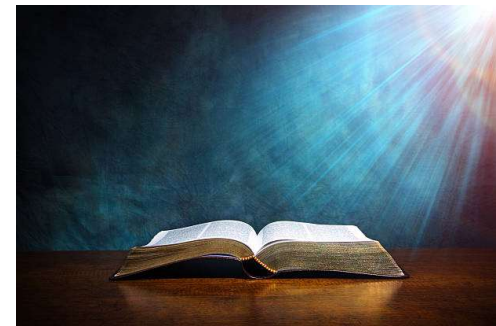
