1. SERVE | relationally

[Mark 10:45; 1 Peter 4:10]

Because Jesus came to serve not to be served, we strive to sacrificially serve others together.

• Free to Serve

Galatians 5:13 ¹³ For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love.

• Created to serve.

Matthew 20:28 ²⁸ For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many."

Serving Like Jesus served

1. Serving is not about *position*, it is about *submission*.

Mark 10

³² They were now on the way up to Jerusalem, and Jesus was walking ahead of them. The disciples were filled with awe, and the people following behind were overwhelmed with fear. Taking the twelve disciples aside, Jesus once more began to describe everything that was about to happen to him. ³³ "Listen," he said, "we're going up to Jerusalem, where the Son of Man will be betrayed to the leading priests and the teachers of religious law. They will sentence him to die and hand him over to the Romans. ³⁴ They will mock him, spit on him, flog him with a whip, and kill him, but after three days he will rise again."

³⁵ Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came over and spoke to him. "Teacher," they said, "we want you to do us a favor."

³⁶ "What is your request?" he asked.

⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. ⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form, ⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal's death on a cross.

2. Serving like Jesus is to do things without expecting <u>recognition</u> or <u>rewards</u> from men.

Hebrews 6:10-12

¹⁰ For God is not unjust. He will not forget how hard you have worked for him and how you have shown your love to him by caring for other believers, as you still do. ¹¹ Our great desire is that you will keep on loving others as long as life lasts, in order to make certain that what you hope for will come true.

3. Serving like Jesus is when you serve <u>others</u> as if you were serving <u>God</u>.

Col. 3:22-24

²³ Work willingly at whatever you do, as though you were working for the Lord rather than for people. ²⁴ Remember that the Lord will give you an inheritance as your reward, and that the Master you are serving is Christ.

4. To serve like Jesus, you must be motivated by *love*.

1 Cor. 13.

[1 Corinthians 9:22-23; Matthew 28:19-20; Luke 10:1-3] Because Jesus is our hope, we aim to reach every generation with His message of salvation.



3. TEACH | transformationally [Romans 12:1-2; 2 Corinthians 3:18; 2 Timothy 3:16-17; Mark 6:34] Because Jesus changes lives, we teach all scripture to form faithful followers of Jesus
