
Studies have shown that in the U.S. Church attendance has Fallen for First Time.

Americans' membership in houses of worship continued to decline last year, dropping below 50% for the first time in Gallup's eight-decade trend.

- In 2020, 47% of Americans said they belonged to a church, synagogue, or mosque
- In 2018 it was 50%
- In 1999 it was 70%.

U.S. church membership was 73% when Gallup first measured it in 1937 and remained near 70% for the next six decades, before beginning a steady decline around the turn of the 21st century.

After the pandemic it went down from 47% to 40%


