Philippians 4 •6 Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. 7 And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

A. Because prayer makes us more like Jesus.

When He faced the death of His friend Lazarus, He prayed



John 11 40.Then Jesus said, "Did I not tell you that if you believe, you will see the glory of God?" 41 So they took away the stone. Then Jesus looked up and said, "Father, I thank you that you have heard me. **<u>42 I knew that you always hear me</u>, but I said this** for the benefit of the people standing here, that they may believe that you sent me."



A. Because prayer makes us more like Jesus.

 When he saw the people in need of food, before he fed the 5000, He prayed.



• Matt. 14 •17 "We have here only five loaves of bread and two fish," they answered. 18 "Bring them here to me," he said. 19 And he directed the people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves.

In the Garden before He was taken by the Romans, <u>He praved</u>.



Matt. 26
36 Then Jesus went with them to a place called Geth semane, and he said to his disciples,
"Sit here, while I go over there and pray.

• 39 And going a little farther <u>He fell on His face and</u> prayed, saying, "My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will."

A. Because prayer makes us more like Jesus.

 Even as he was hanging from the cross, <u>He prayed</u> for His enemies.



• Luke 23:34 "Then Jesus said, 'Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they're doing...'

• Luke 18:1 18 Then Jesus told his disciples a parable to show them that <u>they should always pray and not give up</u>.



B. Because prayer helps us overcome the worries and anxieties of life.

• Philippians 4

• With <u>humbleness:</u>

2 Chronicles 7:14 • ¹⁴ if my people, who are called by my name, <u>will</u> <u>humble themselves and pray</u> and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
