# The average length of a life using the hours of one day

- - 15, the time is 10:25 a.m.
- - If your age is 20, the time is 11:34.
- - If your age is 25, the time is 12:42 p.m.
- - If you're 30, the time is 1:51.
- - If you're 35, the time is 3:00.
- - If you're 40 the time is 4:08.

# The average length of a life using the hours of one day

- - At age 45, the time is 5:15.
- - If you're 50, the time is 6:25.
- - By age 55, the time is 7:24.
- - If you're 60, the time is 8:42.
- - If you're 65, the time is 9:51.
- - And if you you're 70 the time is 11pm
