Day 1 - Seek God's Presence:

Verse: "The Lord is near to the brokenhearted and saves the crushed in spirit." - Psalm 34:18
Reflective Questions:

How can you actively seek God's presence in times of discouragement?

In what ways do you experience the nearness of God during challenging moments?
 Day 2 - Trust in God's Plan:

Verse: "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope." - Jeremiah 29:11

Reflective Questions:

- How can you deepen your trust in God's plan, especially when faced with uncertainty?
- What steps can you take to align your plans with God's purpose for your life?

Day 3 - Find Strength in God's Word:

Verse: "I can do all things through him who strengthens me." - Philippians 4:13 Reflective Questions:

- How can you incorporate God's Word into your daily life for strength and guidance?
- Are there specific verses that resonate with you and offer comfort during tough times?

Day 4 - Cast Your Burdens on Him:

Verse: "Cast your burden on the Lord, and he will sustain you; he will never permit the righteous to be moved." - Psalm 55:22

Reflective Questions:

- What burdens or worries can you consciously surrender to God today?
- In what ways have you experienced God's sustaining power in the past when you cast your burdens on Him?

Day 5 - Be Patient in Tribulation:

Verse: "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer." - Romans 12:12 Reflective Questions:

- How can you cultivate patience during challenging times, trusting in God's timing?
- What role does prayer play in maintaining hope and patience during tribulations?

Day 6 - Focus on the Eternal:

Verse: "So we do not lose heart. Though our outer self is wasting away, our inner self is being renewed day by day." - 2 Corinthians 4:16

Reflective Questions:

- How can you shift your focus from temporary challenges to the eternal perspective?
- In what ways can you nurture your inner self for renewal on a daily basis?

Day 7 - Hold on to God's Promises:

Verse: "And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose." - Romans 8:28

Reflective Questions:

- How can you remind yourself of God's promises during difficult moments?
- What steps can you take to actively live according to God's purpose for your life?
