The book of Psalms contains 150 Hebrew poems, prayers, and songs. 73 of these psalms are directly connected to King David. These 150 psalms span several centuries of Israel's rich history and were compiled together during the period after Israel's exile to Babylon.

The Psalms start by saying,

"Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; But his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night."

This book is designed to be the prayer book for God's chosen people. A people who are striving to be faithful to the Torah (the law) and were eagerly waiting for the messianic kingdom.

This book is all about the lament, praise, faith, and hope of God's people and from it we can learn a lot, today, as we too eagerly anticipate the second coming of our Messiah.

As we journey through the Psalms over the coming weeks, may you see, hear, and experience the fullness of God's presence from the depths of His people's lament to the heights of their praise to God.
