1. FORGIVENESS IS THE FIRST AND MOST BASIC OF ALL OF GOD'S BLESSINGS/BENEFITS TO HIS CHILDREN (vv2-7)

-"BLESS the Lord, O my soul, and all that is within me, BLESS His holy name" +God is so worthy of being blessed because of the benefits we receive

William Dunlop (1692-1720) "to bless God means with ardent affection humbly to acknowledge those divine excellencies which render Him the best and greatest of beings, the only object worthy of the highest adoration...to give Him the praise of all those glorious attributes that adorn his nature...to embrace every proper opportunity of owning our veneration and esteem of his excellent greatness and to declare to all about us, as loudly as we can, the goodness and the grace of his conduct toward men"


- → Notice how David describes God vv4-8

-notice how David describes God vv7-8

- lovingkindness= bow the neck in courtesy to an equal
- compassion= to love, fondle; mercy
- gracious= to favor; stoop in kindness to an inferior
- slow to anger= long in the nostril
- abounding in lovingkindness= to increase, overflow
