The Cross: Back Then Vs Now

The Cross back then was not a pretty sight. It was an ugly, horrible, terrible thing. It was filthy and shameful. It was Rome's way of brutally shaming the worst possible criminal. The criminal would be tied to the wooden poles and hang there and suffer, which would eventually lead to his death. It was the most humiliating way to die.
