¹⁶ "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life

God's love is the fuel that drives His actions and sustains His relationship with us

Perish = to go bad, go rotten... Self-destruction.

Grk. = Apoliumi = Violently kill, destroy fully, it implies permanent and absolute destruction of oneself.

What do we learn from this Text?

1. God's actions were motivated by love. God so loved the world.

2. God's love was voluntary. He gave.

3. God's love was Sacrificial.

1 John 4:9-10

⁹ This is how God showed his love among us: He sent his one and only Son into the world that we might live through him. ¹⁰ This is love: not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

4. God's love is a forgiving love. whoever believes in Him.

Daniel 9:9

"The Lord our God is merciful and forgiving, even though we have rebelled against him."

5. God's Love doesn't condemn.

John 3

¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him. ¹⁸ Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God.

We condemn ourselves.

¹⁹ And this is the judgment: the light has come into the world, and people loved the darkness rather than the light because their works were evil.

- His Love remains.

³⁸ For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, ³⁹ nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
