1. THE MEANING OF "FAVOR"

- → The word "favor" in the Bible has its roots in the concepts of approval and acceptance; being well thought of
- →God extends His favor (or grace), in kindness and compassion toward us

2. THE EXMPLES OF FINDING FAVOR WITH OTHERS

 \rightarrow

- +**Jesus** (Luke 2:52) "and Jesus kept increasing in wisdom and stature, and in **favor** with God and men"
- +Samuel (1 Sam 2:26) "Now the boy Samuel was growing in stature and in **favor** with both God and men"
- +Nehemiah 1:11-2:5 "... grant (me) compassion before this man...if it please the king and if your servant has found **favor** before you, send me to Judah....",
- +Joseph (Gen 39:3-4; 21) "now his master saw that the Lord was with him and how the Lord caused all that he did to prosper in his hand. So Joseph found **favor** in his sight" "But the Lord was with Joseph and extended kindness to him, and gave him **favor** in the sight of the chief jailer"
- **+Esther** 2:17 "The king loved Esther more than all the women, and she found **favor** and kindness with him more than all the virgins, so that he...made her queen..."
- **Prov 22:1 A good name is to be more desired than great wealth, **Favor** is better than silver and gold.

3. THE PATH TO FINDING FAVOR WITH OTHERS- Proverbs 3:3-4

- NASB- "Do not let kindness and truth leave you. Bind them around your neck, Write them on the tablet of your heart. So you will find favor and good repute in the sight of God and man."
- ESV- "Let not steadfast love and faithfulness forsake you"
- NKJV- "Let not mercy and truth forsake you"
- CJB- "Do not let grace and truth leave you"
- NIV- "Let love and faithfulness never leave you"
- NLT- "Never let loyalty and kindness leave you"
- -"kindness" (hesed) is often translated as "mercy" and sometimes as "steadfast love"
- -"faithfulness" is associated with "truth"

SO WHAT? NOW WHAT? TAKING IT HOME!!

 26 He who withholds grain, the people will curse him, But blessing will be on the head of him who sells it. 27 He who diligently seeks good seeks favor, But he who seeks evil, evil will come to him.

 Christ.
- 1 Corinthians 16:17-18 I rejoice over the coming of Stephanas and Fortunatus and Achaicus, because they have supplied what was lacking on your part. 18 For they have **refreshed** my spirit and yours. Therefore acknowledge such men.
- 2 Corinthians 7:13 For this reason we have been comforted. And besides our comfort, we rejoiced even much more for the joy of Titus, because his spirit has been **refreshed** by you all.
- 2 Timothy 7:16 The Lord grant mercy to the house of Onesiphorus, for he often **refreshed** me and was not ashamed of my chains;
- → Sadly, followers of Jesus are often the least generous and rather than refreshing, they bring weariness
